Section 1. Section 83-903, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

3 83-903 The Department of Correctional Services, in consultation with the Board of Parole, shall develop a reentry program for individuals 4 5 incarcerated in a department correctional facility, individuals who have been discharged from a department correctional facility within the prior 6 eighteen months, and parolees. The department shall hire a reentry 7 program administrator to develop and oversee the reentry program and 8 9 additional staff as needed to implement the reentry program. The purpose of the reentry program is to facilitate a standard systemwide program of 10 reentry for individuals leaving correctional facilities or transitioning 11 off community supervision. The primary objectives of the reentry program 12 are to reduce recidivism, to identify, assess, and provide treatment 13 options for individuals with mental illness, to increase public safety, 14 and to improve the overall transition of the individual from the criminal 15 justice system into the community. Prior to the discharge of an 16 individual from a department correctional facility, the department shall 17 provide <u>such individual with an opportunity to obtain a state</u> 18 19 identification card or a motor vehicle operator's license.

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Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2018.
