- 5 (1) Associate degree program means a degree program at a community
- college, state college, or state university which typically requires 6
- 7 completion of an organized program of study of at least sixty semester
- credit hours or an equivalent that can be shown to accomplish the same 8
- 9 qoal. Associate degree program does not include a baccalaureate degree
- program; 10
- (2) Baccalaureate degree program means a degree program at a 11
- community college, state college, or state university which typically 12
- 13 requires completion of an organized program of study of at least one
- hundred twenty semester credit hours or an equivalent that can be shown 14
- to accomplish the same goal; 15
- 16 (3) Child means a resident or nonresident of Nebraska who is the
- 17 child by birth or adoption or the stepchild of a Nebraska law enforcement
- officer killed in the line of duty or a Nebraska firefighter killed in 18
- the line of duty; 19
- (4) Community college means a public postsecondary educational 20
- institution which is part of the community college system and includes 21
- all branches and campuses of such institution located within the State of 22
- 23 Nebraska;
- 24 (5) Education benefit means the In the Line of Duty Dependent
- 25 Education Benefit established under section 85-2304;
- (6) Fatal injury means an event occurring in the line of duty which 26
- is a proximate cause of the death of a law enforcement officer or 27
- 28 firefighter;
- 29 (7) Firefighter means a member of a paid or volunteer fire
- department in Nebraska, including a member of a rescue squad associated 30
- with a paid or volunteer fire department in Nebraska, and a member of an 31

- 1 emergency medical services ambulance squad;
- 2 (8) Law enforcement officer means any person who is responsible for
- 3 the prevention or detection of crime or the enforcement of the penal,
- 4 traffic, or highway laws of the State of Nebraska or any political
- 5 subdivision of the state for more than one hundred hours per year and who
- 6 is authorized by law to make arrests;
- 7 (9) Line of duty means any action that a Nebraska law enforcement
- 8 officer or firefighter is authorized or obligated by law, rule, or
- 9 regulation to perform, related to or as a condition of employment or
- 10 service;
- 11 (10) State college means a public postsecondary educational
- 12 institution which is part of the Nebraska state college system and
- 13 includes all branches and campuses of such institution located within the
- 14 State of Nebraska;
- 15 (11) State university means a public postsecondary educational
- 16 institution which is part of the University of Nebraska and includes all
- 17 branches and campuses of such institution located within the State of
- 18 Nebraska;
- 19 (12) Tuition and fees means the charges and cost of tuition and fees
- 20 as set by the governing body of a state university, state college, or
- 21 community college; and
- 22 (13) Volunteer fire department means a volunteer department as
- 23 defined in section 35-1303 located in Nebraska which provides fire
- 24 protection services within Nebraska.
