- 2 condemners to provide notice to property owners as

- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. (1) Any person authorized to exercise the

- 2 power of eminent domain pursuant to section 57-1101 shall provide the
- 3 notice in subsection (2) of this section to property owners ten days
- 4 prior to commencing negotiation for the property.
- 5 (2) The notice shall be provided to each owner of
- 6 property over or across which any right or interest is to be acquired
- 7 and shall be deemed properly provided if delivered personally or
- 8 mailed by registered or certified mail addressed to the property
- 9 owner at the address shown on the tax records in the office of the
- 10 county treasurer, except that such notice shall be sufficient if
- 11 given to the administrator or executor of the estate of a deceased
- 12 person, the trustee of a trust estate, the guardian of the estate of
- 13 a minor or incompetent person, or a conservator. The notice shall:
- 14 (a) Describe the property proposed to be acquired and the
- 15 compensation to be given for such property;
- 16 (b) Include a statement of the authority for the
- 17 acquisition;
- 18 (c) Include the nature of and necessity and purpose for
- 19 which the land shall be used;
- 20 (d) Include the title, right, or interest in the property
- 21 to be acquired;
- 22 (e) Specify the amount of property needed for the
- 23 <u>project;</u>
- 24 (f) Include reasons for selecting the proposed location
- 25 or route and include a map showing the proposed location or route of

- 1 the project;
- 2 (g) Include a list of the property owner's rights,
- 3 <u>including but not limited to, the right to retain counsel for</u>
- 4 <u>negotiation of just compensation and the proper jurisdiction to</u>
- 5 appeal the proposed location or route of the project; and
- 6 (h) If approval of any agency is required, identify such
- 7 <u>agency</u>.
