Committee:

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to public power suppliers; to provide for the
- filing of an annual report with the Nebraska Power Review Board.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. (1) For purposes of this section, public power supplier

- 2 <u>has the same meaning as in section 70-2103.</u>
- 3 (2) Every public power supplier providing electric service in
- 4 Nebraska shall file an annual report with the Nebraska Power Review Board
- 5 <u>not later than March 15 covering the previous calendar year. The data</u>
- 6 <u>shall be transmitted in a manner required by the board. The report shall</u>
- 7 include the following:
- 8 (a) The average electric rate charged in each of the following rate
- 9 classes:
- 10 <u>(i) Residential;</u>
- 11 (ii) Commercial;
- 12 (iii) Industrial; and
- 13 <u>(iv) Agricultural;</u>
- (b) The number of customers in each rate class;
- 15 (c) A list of all non-electricity charges and the amount of each
- 16 charge;
- 17 (d) The total electricity sold in the previous calendar year;
- (e) The sources of electricity generation or power purchases sold;
- 19 <u>(f) The total cost of each generation or power purchase including:</u>
- 20 (i) Fuel costs;
- 21 <u>(ii) Transportation costs;</u>
- 22 (iii) Transmission costs to reach the customer;
- 23 (iv) Administration and overhead costs;
- 24 <u>(v) Employee salaries;</u>
- 25 (vi) Capital costs; and
- 26 (vii) Other contract provisions;
- 27 <u>(g) Any wholesale customers details;</u>
- 28 (h) Generation details including:
- 29 <u>(i) Emission of the following pollutants:</u>
- 30 <u>(A) Carbon dioxide;</u>
- 31 (B) Mono-nitrogen oxides;

- 1 (C) Sulfur oxides; and
- 2 (D) Heavy metals;
- 3 (ii) Atmospheric particulate matter emitted; and
- 4 (iii) Both consumptive and nonconsumptive use of water;
- 5 <u>(i) Public power supplier board member information including:</u>
- 6 (i) Names and contact information;
- 7 (ii) A description of how the board members are selected; and
- 8 (iii) Any benefits provided to the board members including, but not
- 9 <u>limited to, direct compensation and reimbursements;</u>
- 10 (j) Staff information including:
- (i) The name, title, and annual salary and benefits of the manager;
- 12 <u>(ii) The names, titles, and annual salaries and benefits of all</u>
- 13 <u>other administrators; and</u>
- 14 (iii) The job classifications, number, and average annual
- 15 compensation of all other employees;
- 16 (k) A link to the public power supplier's net metering policy which
- 17 includes:
- 18 <u>(i) The number of qualified facilities;</u>
- 19 <u>(ii) The avoided cost price;</u>
- 20 (iii) The qualified system size limit;
- 21 <u>(iv) The required connection fees; and</u>
- 22 (v) The required amount of insurance;
- 23 <u>(1) A list of programs offered to customers and a link to</u>
- 24 information regarding those programs;
- 25 (m) A description of advertising used and the amount spent for
- 26 <u>advertising;</u>
- 27 (n) The names of all organizations to which the public power
- 28 supplier belongs, including the membership dues paid to each
- 29 <u>organization;</u>
- 30 (o) A map of the public power supplier's service area;
- 31 (p) A link to the public power supplier's financial statements; and

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1	(q) The amount and type of tax or in lieu of tax payments made.
2	(3) The Nebraska Power Review Board shall publish the filed annual
3	reports on its web site. The board shall create an electronic data base

available to the public which allows searches and comparisons between all

5 <u>public power suppliers in Nebraska.</u>

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
