Section 1. Section 48-601, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 3 48-601 Sections 48-601 to 48-683 and section 2 of this act shall be
- 4 known and may be cited as the Employment Security Law.
- 5 Sec. 2. (1) An individual shall be disqualified for benefits for
- 6 <u>any week in which he or she:</u>
- 7 (a) Fails to respond to an offer for a job within two business days;
- 8 <u>or</u>
- 9 (b) Fails to appear for a previously scheduled job interview without
- 10 <u>notifying the prospective employer of the need to cancel or reschedule</u>
- 11 the interview.
- 12 (2) The department shall establish a portal on its website, an email
- 13 address, and a telephone hotline for employers to report individuals who
- 14 <u>fail to respond to offers of employment or who fail to appear for</u>
- 15 previously scheduled job interviews.
- 16 (3) Prior to denying a week of benefits to an individual pursuant to
- 17 this section, the department shall verify any information submitted by an
- 18 employer pursuant to subsection (2) of this section.

- 20 Nebraska, is repealed.
