1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Livestock Brand Act; to amend section
2 54-189, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change
3 satisfactory evidence of ownership; and to repeal the
4 original section.

5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 54-189, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 54-189 Satisfactory evidence of ownership consists of the
4 brands, tattoos, or marks on the livestock; point of origin of
5 livestock; the physical description of the livestock; and the
6 documentary evidence, such as bills of sale, brand clearance,
7 certificates of inspection, breed registration certificates, animal
8 health or testing certificates, recorded brand certificates, purchase
9 sheets, scale tickets, disclaimers of interest, affidavits, court
10 orders, security agreements, powers of attorney, canceled checks,
11 bills of lading, or tags. ~~; and such other facts, statements, or~~
12 ~~circumstances that taken in whole or in part cause an inspector to~~
13 ~~believe that proof of ownership is established.~~
