- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to judges' salaries; to amend section
- 2 24-201.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2014; to change
- 3 the salary of Supreme Court judges; to provide an operative date; to
- 4 repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 24-201.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative
2 Supplement, 2014, is amended to read:

3 ~~24-201.01 On July 1, 2012, the salary of the Chief Justice and the~~
4 ~~judges of the Supreme Court shall be one hundred forty-five thousand six~~
5 ~~hundred fourteen dollars and seventy four cents. On July 1, 2013, the~~
6 ~~salary of the Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall be~~
7 ~~one hundred fifty-two thousand eight hundred ninety-five dollars and~~
8 ~~forty-eight cents. On July 1, 2014, the salary of the Chief Justice and~~
9 ~~the judges of the Supreme Court shall be one hundred sixty thousand five~~
10 ~~hundred forty dollars and twenty-five cents. On July 1, 2015, the salary~~
11 ~~of the Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall be one~~
12 ~~hundred sixty-four thousand one hundred fifty-two dollars and forty-one~~
13 ~~cents. On July 1, 2016, the salary of the Chief Justice and the judges of~~
14 ~~the Supreme Court shall be one hundred sixty-eight thousand ninety-two~~
15 ~~dollars and six cents.~~

16 The Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall hold no
17 other public office of profit or trust during their terms of office nor
18 accept any public appointment or employment under the authority of the
19 government of the United States for which they receive compensation for
20 their services. Such salaries shall be payable in equal monthly
21 installments.

22 Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2015.

23 Sec. 3. Original section 24-201.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative
24 Supplement, 2014, is repealed.

25 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
26 passed and approved according to law.
