- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- **Section 1.** Section 49-1401, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 2 2024, is amended to read:
- 3 49-1401 Sections 49-1401 to 49-14,142 <u>and section 2 of this act</u>
- 4 shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Political Accountability
- 5 and Disclosure Act.
- 6 Sec. 2. No person shall make one or more contributions to a
- 7 candidate committee totaling more than one thousand dollars during an
- 8 <u>election period</u>. A candidate committee shall, within ten days after
- 9 receipt, refund any contribution from a person which exceeds a total of
- 10 <u>one thousand dollars received during an election period from such person</u>
- 11 and report such contribution on subsequent campaign statements disclosing
- 12 the name and address of the contributor, the amount received, the date of
- 13 receipt, and the date returned. This section does not apply to a
- 14 candidate's own personal funds contributed to that candidate's committee.
- 15 For purposes of this section, election period means the calendar year of
- 16 the election.
- 17 Sec. 3. Original section 49-1401, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 18 Supplement, 2024, is repealed.
