- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Racetrack Gaming Act; to amend
- 2 section 4, Initiative Law 2020, No. 431; to change provisions
- 3 relating to the distribution of funds collected under the Nebraska
- 4 Racetrack Gaming Act; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 4, Initiative Law 2020, No. 431, is amended to
- 2 read:
- 3 Sec. 4. (1) Of the tax imposed by section 3 of this act, seventy-
- 4 five percent shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit as
- 5 follows: Two and one-half percent to the Compulsive Gamblers Assistance
- 6 Fund, two and one-half percent to the General Fund, and seventy percent
- 7 to the Property Tax Credit Cash Fund. The remaining twenty-five percent
- 8 of the tax shall be remitted to the county treasurer of the county in
- 9 which the licensed racetrack enclosure is located to be distributed as
- 10 provided in subsection (2) of this section.
- 11 (2) Ten percent of the distribution remitted to the county treasurer
- 12 <u>shall be distributed to the county agricultural society in the county in</u>
- 13 <u>which the licensed racetrack enclosure is located, if such county</u>
- 14 <u>agricultural society has been formed in the county under the County</u>
- 15 Agricultural Society Act. Following any distribution to a county
- 16 agricultural society, the remaining funds shall be distributed by the
- 17 county treasurer as follows: (a) (1) If the licensed racetrack enclosure
- 18 is located completely within an unincorporated area of a county, the
- 19 remaining funds twenty-five percent shall be distributed to the county in
- 20 which such licensed racetrack enclosure is located; or (b) (2) if the
- 21 licensed racetrack enclosure is located at least partially within the
- 22 limits of a city or village in such county, one-half of the remaining
- 23 funds twenty-five percent shall be distributed to such county and one-
- 24 half of the remaining funds twenty-five percent to the city or village in
- 25 which such licensed racetrack enclosure is at least partially located.
- Sec. 2. Original section 4, Initiative Law 2020, No. 431, is
- 27 repealed.
