- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 71-604.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,
 is amended to read:

71-604.01 (1) Upon receipt of an application for a new certificate 3 4 of birth, which shall be accompanied by a notarized affidavit from the physician that performed sex confirmation reassignment surgery on an 5 individual born in this state and a certified copy of an order of a court 6 7 of competent jurisdiction changing the name of such person, the department shall prepare a new certificate of birth in the new name and 8 9 sex of such person in substantially the same form as that used for other 10 live births. The evidence from which the new certificate is prepared and the original certificate of birth shall be available for inspection only 11 upon the order of a court of competent jurisdiction. 12

13 (2) Upon receipt of a complete application to amend the sex on a certificate of birth from a person born in this state or the parent, 14 quardian, or legal representative of such person, the department shall 15 amend the sex on such certificate of birth. A complete application to 16 17 amend the sex on a certificate of birth shall be accompanied by either (a) an affidavit from a physician stating such amendment to the 18 certificate of birth is warranted and documentary evidence to 19 substantiate such amendment or (b) a certified copy of a court order 20 directing amendment of the certificate of birth to reflect such change. 21

22 (3)(a) Any person desiring to change the sex listed on the birth certificate may file a petition in the district court of the county in 23 which such person may be a resident, setting forth (i) that the 24 25 petitioner has been a bona fide citizen of such county for at least one year prior to the filing of the petition, (ii) the address of the 26 27 petitioner, (iii) the date of birth of the petitioner, (iv) the cause for 28 which the change of petitioner's sex is sought, and (v) the sex asked 29 for.

30 (b) It shall be the duty of the district court, upon being duly
 31 satisfied by proof in open court of the truth of the allegations set

forth in the petition, that there exists proper and reasonable cause for changing the sex of the petitioner, to order and direct a change of sex of such petitioner and that an order for the purpose be entered by the court.
(c) The clerk of the district court shall deliver a copy of any sexchange order issued by the court pursuant to this section to the Department of Health and Human Services for use pursuant to this section.
