- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. <u>There is hereby appropriated \$26,000,000 from the</u>
2	<u>General Fund and \$34,482,216 from Federal Funds for FY2022-23 to the</u>
3	Department of Health and Human Services, for Program 348, for purposes of
4	raising the base for funding appropriations for FY2022-23.
5	There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2022-23
6	<u>\$26,000,000 General Funds and \$34,482,216 Federal Funds for state aid,</u>
7	which shall only be used for such purpose.
8	No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
9	for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
10	section.
11	<u>It is the intent of the Legislature that the total FY2022-23</u>
12	appropriation for nursing facility services, including the additional
13	<u>\$60,482,216 (\$26,000,000 General Funds and \$34,482,216 Federal Funds),</u>
14	the 2% rate enhancement, and the 1.5% utilization adjustment, be used as
15	the base for funding appropriations in FY2023-24.
16	It is the intent of the Legislature that the additional amount
17	appropriated for medicaid nursing facility rates for Program 348,
18	<u>specified as \$60,482,216 (\$26,000,000 General Funds and \$34,482,216</u>
19	Federal Funds), the 2% rate enhancement, and the 1.5% utilization
20	adjustment, for FY2022-23, be used in the medicaid nursing facility rate
21	calculation for Program 348, including the calculation of the annual
22	<u>inflation factor.</u>
23	Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when

24 passed and approved according to law.
