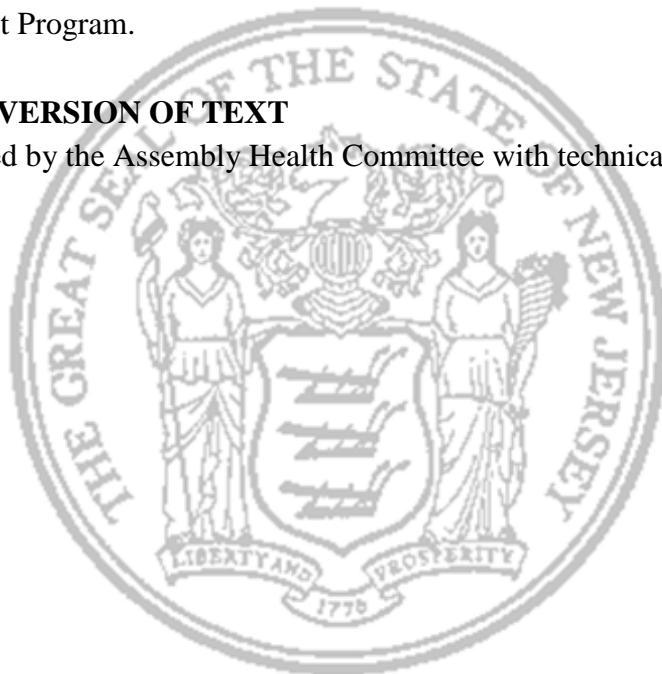

7 1. In addition to the amounts appropriated under P.L.2024,
8 c.22, the annual appropriations act for the fiscal year ending June
9 30, 2025, there is appropriated from the General Fund the following

24 The amount hereinabove appropriated for the Huntington Disease
25 Grant Program, in addition to any other State or federal funds
26 allocated for the following purposes, shall be allocated to support
27 grants to institutions of higher education, non-profit
28 organizations, or New Jersey based and operated research
29 organizations for the provision of pre-symptomatic testing,
30 neurology and psychiatry services, neurophysiological
31 evaluations, treatment, disease management, and counseling for
32 people living with or at risk for Huntington's Disease.
