AN ACT

RELATING TO GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FROM LEGISLATIVE CASH BALANCES FOR NECESSARY EXPENSES OF THE SECOND SPECIAL SESSION OF THE FIFTY-FIFTH LEGISLATURE; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE HOUSE AND SENATE CHIEF CLERKS' OFFICES FOR LEADERSHIP STAFF AND ONGOING OPERATIONAL EXPENSES; MAKING CONTINGENT APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE APPROPRIATION CONTINGENCY FUND FOR NECESSARY JUDICIAL AND EXECUTIVE BRANCH EXPENSES RELATED TO PRETRIAL SERVICES MONITORING AND ADMINISTRATION, ACCOUNTING AND REPORTING OF FUNDS RECEIVED BY THE STATE PURSUANT TO THE FEDERAL AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. SPECIAL SESSION--APPROPRIATION.--

A. The following amounts are appropriated from

1 legislative cash balances for expenditure in fiscal year 2022
2 for the following expenses of the second special session of the
3 fifty-fifth legislature:

4 (1) for the expense of the house of
5 representatives, three hundred twenty-two thousand three
6 hundred dollars (\$322,300) to be disbursed on vouchers signed
7 by the speaker and the chief clerk of the house of
8 representatives or the chief clerk's designee;

9 (2) for the expense of the senate, three
10 hundred five thousand four hundred dollars (\$305,400) to be
11 disbursed on vouchers signed by the chair of the committees'
12 committee and the chief clerk of the senate or the chief
13 clerk's designee; and

14 (3) for the expense of the legislative council
15 service, two hundred eighty-six thousand four hundred dollars
16 (\$286,400) to be disbursed on vouchers signed by the director
17 of the legislative council service or the director's designee.

18 B. Following adjournment of the second special
19 session of the fifty-fifth legislature, expenditures authorized
20 in this section shall be disbursed on vouchers signed by the
21 director of the legislative council service or the director's
22 designee.

23 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS--GENERAL FUND--HOUSE AND SENATE
24 LEADERSHIP STAFF AND ONGOING OPERATIONAL EXPENSES.--

25 A. There is appropriated from the general fund to

1 the legislative council service for expenditure in fiscal years
2 2022 and 2023:

3 (1) three hundred fifty thousand dollars
4 (\$350,000) to the house chief clerk's office for leadership
5 staff and ongoing operational expenses as determined by house
6 leadership, to be disbursed on vouchers signed by the director
7 of the legislative council service; and

8 (2) three hundred fifty thousand dollars
9 (\$350,000) to the senate chief clerk's office for leadership
10 staff and ongoing operational expenses as determined by senate
11 leadership, to be disbursed on vouchers signed by the director
12 of the legislative council service.

13 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
14 at the end of fiscal year 2023 shall revert to the general
15 fund.

16 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS--APPROPRIATION CONTINGENCY
17 FUND--EXECUTIVE AND JUDICIAL BRANCHES.--Contingent upon the
18 transfer of federal funds received in the state treasury in the
19 coronavirus state fiscal recovery fund pursuant to the federal
20 American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, Sec. 9901, Public Law 117-2,
21 135 Stat. 223, to the appropriation contingency fund pursuant
22 to legislation of the second special session of the fifty-fifth
23 legislature, making general appropriations and authorizing
24 expenditures, the following amounts are appropriated from that
25 amount transferred to the appropriation contingency fund for
.221635.3

1 expenditure in fiscal years 2022 through 2025, and any
2 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
3 fiscal year 2025 shall revert to the appropriation contingency
4 fund:

5 A. five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to the
6 administrative office of the courts for pretrial services
7 monitoring; and

8 B. one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to the
9 department of finance and administration for costs relating to
10 the administering, accounting and reporting of funds received
11 by the state pursuant to the federal American Rescue Plan Act
12 of 2021.
