10 AN ACT

11 RELATING TO HISTORIC SITES; RENAMING THE CORONADO HISTORIC SITE
12 AS THE "KUAUA PUEBLO HISTORIC SITE".

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 SECTION 1. Section 18-3-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1975,
16 Chapter 264, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

17 "18-3-1. MUSEUM OF NEW MEXICO ESTABLISHED--LOCATION--
18 PROPERTY.--

19 A. The "museum of New Mexico" is established. All
20 properties, real or personal, now held for museum purposes and
21 all properties, real or personal, that may be acquired for
22 museum purposes at any time in the future shall be under
23 the control of the museum board of regents of the museum of New
24 Mexico.

25 B. The museum of New Mexico consists of:

- 3 (2) the New Mexico museum of art;
- 4 (3) the museum of Indian arts and culture;
- 5 (4) the museum of international folk art;
- 6 (5) the archaeology division; and
- 7 (6) the state historic sites:
 - 8 (a) [~~Coronado~~] Kuaua Pueblo historic
 - 9 site;
 - 10 (b) Jemez historic site;
 - 11 (c) Fort Selden historic site;
 - 12 (d) Bosque Redondo memorial and Fort
 - 13 Sumner historic site;
 - 14 (e) Lincoln historic site;
 - 15 (f) El Camino Real historic trail site;
 - 16 (g) Fort Stanton historic site; and
 - 17 (h) Taylor Reynolds Barela Mesilla
 - 18 historic site."

19 SECTION 2. Section 18-3-16 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2004,
20 Chapter 25, Section 17, as amended) is amended to read:

21 "18-3-16. STATE HISTORIC SITES AND MONUMENTS DIVISION
22 CREATED--BOARD OF REGENTS.--

23 A. The "state historic sites and monuments
24 division" is created in the cultural affairs department. The
25 division shall manage the state's historic sites and monuments,

- 3 (2) Jemez historic site;
- 4 (3) Fort Selden historic site;
- 5 (4) Bosque Redondo memorial and Fort Sumner
- 6 historic site;
- 7 (5) Lincoln historic site;
- 8 (6) El Camino Real historic trail site;
- 9 (7) Fort Stanton historic site; and
- 10 (8) Taylor Reynolds Barela Mesilla historic
- 11 site.

12 B. The state's historic sites shall operate under
13 the imprimatur of the museum of New Mexico. The museum of New
14 Mexico board of regents shall exercise trusteeship over state
15 historic sites.

16 C. The director of the division shall meet the
17 following minimum qualifications:

- 18 (1) hold a bachelor's or higher degree in a
- 19 discipline related to the function of the division; and
- 20 (2) have significant experience in the
- 21 management and operation of an organization similar to the
- 22 division.

23 D. The director shall be appointed by the secretary
24 of cultural affairs from a list of no less than three names
25 provided by the museum of New Mexico board of regents."
