BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

## SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. --

- A. The following amounts are appropriated from the general fund to the aging and long-term services department for expenditure in fiscal year 2020 to fund the following programs and services:
- (1) one million two hundred ninety-five thousand seven hundred thirty-eight dollars (\$1,295,738) for the following senior services delivered through the four area agencies on aging:
  - (a) adult daycare;
  - (b) case management;

5	(g) senior center services;
6	(2) one hundred six thousand ninety dollars
7	(\$106,090) for volunteer programs, including foster

10	(\$35,020) to fund evidence-based Alzheimer's programming in
