

HOUSE TAXATION AND REVENUE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL 55

51ST LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - SECOND SESSION, 2014

AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; ENACTING THE 2014 WORK NEW
MEXICO ACT; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SEVERANCE TAX BONDS;
AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES FROM CERTAIN FUNDS AND BALANCES;
CLARIFYING CONDITIONS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS; ESTABLISHING
CONDITIONS FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF SEVERANCE TAX BOND PROCEEDS;
ESTABLISHING CONDITIONS FOR THE REVERSION OF UNEXPENDED
BALANCES; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.--This act may be cited as the
"2014 Work New Mexico Act".

SECTION 2. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--AUTHORIZATIONS--
APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS.--

A. The state board of finance may issue and sell
severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax

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1 Bonding Act in an amount not to exceed the total of the amounts
2 authorized for purposes specified in the 2014 Work New Mexico
3 Act. The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance
4 and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical
5 manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project
6 has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and
7 that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable
8 time. The state board of finance shall further take the
9 appropriate steps necessary to comply with the federal Internal
10 Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. Proceeds from the sale of
11 the bonds are appropriated for the purposes specified in the
12 2014 Work New Mexico Act.

13 B. The agencies named in the 2014 Work New Mexico
14 Act shall certify to the state board of finance when the money
15 from the proceeds of the severance tax bonds appropriated in
16 this section is needed for the purposes specified in the
17 applicable section of that act. If an agency has not certified
18 the need for severance tax bond proceeds for a particular
19 project, including projects that have been reauthorized, by the
20 end of fiscal year 2016, the authorization for that project is
21 void.

22 C. Before an agency may certify for the need of
23 severance tax bond proceeds, the project must be developed
24 sufficiently so that the agency reasonably expects to:

- 25 (1) incur within six months after the

1 applicable bond proceeds are available for the project a
2 substantial binding obligation to a third party to expend at
3 least five percent of the bond proceeds for the project; and

4 (2) spend at least eighty-five percent of the
5 bond proceeds within three years after the applicable bond
6 proceeds are available for the project.

7 D. Except as otherwise specifically provided by
8 law:

9 (1) the unexpended balance from the proceeds
10 of severance tax bonds appropriated in the 2014 Work New Mexico
11 Act for a project shall revert to the severance tax bonding
12 fund no later than the following dates:

13 (a) for a project for which severance
14 tax bond proceeds were appropriated to match federal grants,
15 six months after completion of the project;

16 (b) for a project for which severance
17 tax bond proceeds were appropriated to purchase vehicles,
18 including emergency vehicles and other vehicles that require
19 special equipment; heavy equipment; books; educational
20 technology; or other equipment or furniture that is not related
21 to a more inclusive construction or renovation project, at the
22 end of the fiscal year two years following the fiscal year in
23 which the severance tax bond proceeds were made available for
24 the purchase; and

25 (c) for any other project for which

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1 severance tax bonds were appropriated, within six months of
2 completion of the project, but no later than the end of fiscal
3 year 2018; and

4 (2) all remaining balances from the proceeds
5 of severance tax bonds appropriated for a project in the 2014
6 Work New Mexico Act shall revert to the severance tax bonding
7 fund three months after the latest reversion date specified for
8 that type of project in Paragraph (1) of this subsection.

9 E. Except for appropriations to the capital program
10 fund, money from severance tax bond proceeds provided pursuant
11 to the 2014 Work New Mexico Act shall not be used to pay
12 indirect project costs.

13 F. Except for a project that was originally funded
14 using a tax-exempt loan or bond issue, a project involving
15 repayment of debt previously incurred shall be funded through
16 the issuance of taxable severance tax bonds with a term that
17 does not extend beyond the fiscal year in which they are
18 issued.

19 G. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
20 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
21 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding
22 written obligations to third parties.

23 SECTION 3. GENERAL FUND AND OTHER FUND APPROPRIATIONS--
24 LIMITATIONS--REVERSIONS.--

25 A. Except as otherwise specifically provided by

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1 law:

2 (1) the unexpended balance of an appropriation
3 made in the 2014 Work New Mexico Act from the general fund or
4 other state funds shall revert no later than the following
5 dates:

6 (a) for a project for which an
7 appropriation was made to match federal grants, six months
8 after completion of the project;

9 (b) for a project for which an
10 appropriation was made to purchase vehicles, including
11 emergency vehicles and other vehicles that require special
12 equipment; heavy equipment; books; educational technology; or
13 other equipment or furniture that is not related to a more
14 inclusive construction or renovation project, at the end of the
15 fiscal year two years following the fiscal year in which the
16 appropriation was made for the purchase; and

17 (c) for any other project for which an
18 appropriation was made, within six months of completion of the
19 project, but no later than the end of fiscal year 2018; and

20 (2) all remaining balances from an
21 appropriation made in the 2014 Work New Mexico Act for a
22 project shall revert three months after the latest reversion
23 date specified for that type of project in Paragraph (1) of
24 this subsection.

25 B. Except for appropriations to the capital program

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1 fund, money from appropriations made in the 2014 Work New
2 Mexico Act shall not be used to pay indirect project costs.

3 C. Except as provided in Subsection E of this
4 section, the balance of an appropriation made from the general
5 fund shall revert in the time frame set forth in Subsection A
6 of this section to the capital projects fund.

7 D. Except as provided in Subsection E of this
8 section, the balance of an appropriation made from other state
9 funds shall revert in the time frame set forth in Subsection A
10 of this section to the originating fund.

11 E. The balance of an appropriation made from the
12 general fund or other state fund to the Indian affairs
13 department or the aging and long-term services department for a
14 project located on lands of an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo
15 shall revert in the time frame set forth in Subsection A of
16 this section to the tribal infrastructure project fund.

17 F. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
18 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
19 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding
20 written obligations to third parties.

21 SECTION 4. AGING AND LONG-TERM SERVICES DEPARTMENT
22 PROJECTS--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of
23 Section 2 of the 2014 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification
24 by the aging and long-term services department that the need
25 exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are

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1 appropriated to the aging and long-term services department for
2 the following purposes:

3 1. five thousand dollars (\$5,000) to purchase,
4 plan, design, construct, renovate, equip and furnish the
5 department of senior affairs home service facility in
6 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

7 2. one hundred seven thousand five hundred dollars
8 (\$107,500) to plan, design, renovate and improve the North
9 Domingo Baca multigenerational center in Albuquerque in
10 Bernalillo county;

11 3. one hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000)
12 to plan, design, construct, renovate, equip and furnish the
13 North Valley senior center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

14 4. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to plan,
15 design, construct and equip an exercise center and to purchase
16 a van for the senior center in the Pueblo of Acoma in Cibola
17 county;

18 5. one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to
19 plan, design and construct a parking lot, including lighting,
20 at the senior center in the Chichiltah chapter of the Navajo
21 Nation in McKinley county; and

22 6. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to design and
23 construct an addition to the senior center in the Two Grey
24 Hills chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county.

25 SECTION 5. STATE ARMORY BOARD PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX

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1 BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2 of the 2014
2 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification by the state armory
3 board that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, five
4 hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) is appropriated to the
5 state armory board for improvements, repairs and demolition,
6 including energy-efficient systems, to correct infrastructure
7 deficiencies and staging areas at facilities statewide.

8 SECTION 6. CAPITAL PROGRAM FUND PROJECTS--SEVERANCE TAX

9 BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2 of the 2014
10 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification by the facilities
11 management division of the general services department that the
12 need exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following
13 amounts are appropriated to the capital program fund for the
14 following purposes:

15 1. one hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$160,000) to
16 plan, design and construct offices, a civil rights museum and
17 library for the Martin Luther King, Jr. commission in
18 Bernalillo or Sandoval county; and

19 2. two million dollars (\$2,000,000) to plan,
20 design, repair and renovate correctional facilities statewide
21 to address security and safety hazards, operational
22 interruptions and facility deterioration.

23 SECTION 7. CULTURAL AFFAIRS DEPARTMENT PROJECTS--

24 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2
25 of the 2014 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification by the

1 cultural affairs department that the need exists for the
 2 issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated
 3 to the cultural affairs department for the following purposes:

4 1. one hundred ten thousand dollars (\$110,000) to
 5 replace the planetarium projection system at the New Mexico
 6 museum of natural history and science in Albuquerque in
 7 Bernalillo county;

8 2. one hundred thirty-five thousand dollars
 9 (\$135,000) to purchase and install dividers in classrooms and
 10 the multipurpose hall of the education building at the national
 11 Hispanic cultural center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

12 3. five hundred sixty-four thousand dollars
 13 (\$564,000) to plan, design, construct, equip and furnish an
 14 information and welcome center at the entrance of the national
 15 Hispanic cultural center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

16 4. ninety-six thousand five hundred dollars
 17 (\$96,500) to plan, design and construct improvements and
 18 repairs to the center for contemporary arts in Santa Fe in
 19 Santa Fe county; and

20 5. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to
 21 purchase, design and construct a bookmobile vehicle for the New
 22 Mexico state library.

23 SECTION 8. CUMBRES AND TOLTEC SCENIC RAILROAD COMMISSION
 24 PROJECTS--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of
 25 Section 2 of the 2014 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification

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1 by the Cumbres and Toltec scenic railroad commission that the
2 need exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following
3 amounts are appropriated to the Cumbres and Toltec scenic
4 railroad commission for the following purposes:

5 1. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for land
6 acquisition and extension of track for the Cumbres and Toltec
7 scenic railroad that operates between New Mexico and Colorado;
8 and

9 2. eighty-five thousand dollars (\$85,000) to
10 purchase and upgrade narrow gauge diesel locomotive number 15
11 for the Cumbres and Toltec scenic railroad that operates
12 between New Mexico and Colorado.

13 SECTION 9. DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF THE TENTH JUDICIAL
14 DISTRICT PROJECTS--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the
15 provisions of Section 2 of the 2014 Work New Mexico Act, upon
16 certification by the district attorney of the tenth judicial
17 district that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds,
18 the following amounts are appropriated to the district attorney
19 of the tenth judicial district for the following purposes:

20 1. twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000) to
21 furnish and equip an office in the county courthouse for the
22 tenth judicial district attorney in Fort Sumner in De Baca
23 county; and

24 2. fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) to replace a
25 computer server for the tenth judicial district attorney's

1 office in Tucumcari in Quay county.

2 SECTION 10. FIRST JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT PROJECTS--
3 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2
4 of the 2014 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification by the
5 first judicial district court that the need exists for the
6 issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated
7 to the first judicial district court for the following
8 purposes:

9 1. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to purchase and
10 install information technology, including related equipment,
11 furniture and infrastructure, for the first judicial district
12 courthouse in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county; and

13 2. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to
14 purchase and install outdoor public seating at the first
15 judicial district courthouse in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county.

16 SECTION 11. SECOND JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT PROJECTS--
17 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2
18 of the 2014 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification by the
19 second judicial district court that the need exists for the
20 issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated
21 to the second judicial district court for the following
22 purposes:

23 1. ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) to purchase
24 and install a court reporting system in courtrooms in the
25 second judicial district court in Albuquerque in Bernalillo

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1 county;

2 2. one hundred fifty-five thousand dollars
3 (\$155,000) to purchase and install evidence presentation
4 systems in courtrooms in the second judicial district court in
5 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county; and

6 3. seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000) to purchase
7 and install a telephone system in the second judicial district
8 court facilities in Bernalillo county.

9 SECTION 12. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT PROJECT--
10 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2
11 of the 2014 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification by the
12 economic development department that the need exists for the
13 issuance of the bonds, five million dollars (\$5,000,000) is
14 appropriated to the economic development department for
15 economic development projects statewide pursuant to the Local
16 Economic Development Act.

17 SECTION 13. PUBLIC EDUCATION DEPARTMENT PROJECTS--
18 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2
19 of the 2014 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification by the
20 public education department that the need exists for the
21 issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated
22 to the public education department for the following purposes:

23 1. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan,
24 design, construct, purchase and install infrastructure
25 improvements and bleachers in the gymnasium at Eldorado high

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1 school in the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo
2 county;

3 2. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to plan,
4 design, construct, improve, renovate and equip the grounds and
5 playgrounds, including landscaping, fencing and drainage, at
6 Adobe Acres elementary school in the Albuquerque public school
7 district in Bernalillo county;

8 3. four thousand dollars (\$4,000) to plan, design,
9 equip and furnish Alameda elementary school in the Albuquerque
10 public school district in Bernalillo county;

11 4. forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) to plan,
12 design, construct, improve, renovate and equip the grounds and
13 playgrounds, including landscaping, fencing and drainage, at
14 Alameda elementary school in the Albuquerque public school
15 district in Bernalillo county;

16 5. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to
17 purchase and install information technology, including related
18 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at Alamosa elementary
19 school in the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo
20 county;

21 6. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to construct an
22 expansion at the Albuquerque institute for mathematics and
23 science in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

24 7. two hundred eighty thousand dollars (\$280,000)
25 to plan, design, construct, equip and renovate the grounds and

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1 playgrounds, including fencing, drainage and landscaping
2 improvements, at the autism center in the Albuquerque public
3 school district in Bernalillo county;

4 8. thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) to
5 purchase and install information technology, including related
6 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at the autism center
7 in the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo county;

8 9. thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) to purchase
9 and install information technology, including related
10 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, for special education
11 transition services in the Albuquerque public school district
12 in Bernalillo county;

13 10. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to purchase
14 and install a scoreboard and athletic equipment for the
15 Albuquerque high school baseball program in the Albuquerque
16 public school district in Bernalillo county;

17 11. thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) to purchase
18 and install information technology, including related
19 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at Albuquerque high
20 school in the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo
21 county;

22 12. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to purchase
23 and install information technology, including related
24 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at Alvarado elementary
25 school in the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo

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1 county;

2 13. five thousand dollars (\$5,000) to design,
3 construct and equip a building security system at Amy Biehl
4 high school in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

5 14. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to plan,
6 design, construct, equip and furnish renovations to the front
7 offices, interior walls and heating, ventilation and air
8 conditioning system at Amy Biehl high school in Albuquerque in
9 Bernalillo county;

10 15. thirteen thousand seven hundred fifty dollars
11 (\$13,750) to purchase and install a security fence and gate for
12 the back dock and alley area with security cameras and lighting
13 at Amy Biehl high school in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

14 16. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to purchase
15 and install information technology, including related
16 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at Apache elementary
17 school in the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo
18 county;

19 17. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to
20 purchase and install security cameras and information
21 technology, including related equipment, furniture and
22 infrastructure, at Apache elementary school in the Albuquerque
23 public school district in Bernalillo county;

24 18. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
25 purchase and install information technology, including related

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1 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at Del Norte and
2 Valley high schools, Garfield middle school, the juvenile
3 detention center educational unit and Griegos, La Luz, Los
4 Ranchos, MacArthur and Mission Avenue elementary schools in the
5 Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo county;

6 19. eighty-seven thousand dollars (\$87,000) to
7 purchase a transportation trailer and to equip the junior
8 reserves officers training corps program in the Albuquerque
9 public school district in Bernalillo county;

10 20. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to purchase
11 and install information technology, including related
12 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at Armijo elementary
13 school in the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo
14 county;

15 21. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
16 purchase and install information technology, including related
17 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at Arroyo del Oso
18 elementary school in the Albuquerque public school district in
19 Bernalillo county;

20 22. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to
21 purchase and install information technology, including related
22 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at Atrisco elementary
23 school in the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo
24 county;

25 23. thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) to

1 purchase and install information technology, including related
2 furniture, equipment and infrastructure, at Atrisco Heritage
3 high school in the Albuquerque public school district in
4 Bernalillo county;

5 24. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to plan,
6 design, construct, improve, renovate and equip the grounds and
7 playgrounds, including landscaping, fencing and drainage, at
8 Bandelier elementary school in the Albuquerque public school
9 district in Bernalillo county;

10 25. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to purchase
11 and install information technology, including related
12 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at Bandelier
13 elementary school in the Albuquerque public school district in
14 Bernalillo county;

15 26. twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to purchase
16 and install library equipment, furniture, information
17 technology and infrastructure at Bandelier elementary school in
18 the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo county;

19 27. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to purchase
20 and install information technology, including related
21 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at Bel-Air elementary
22 school in the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo
23 county;

24 28. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to
25 purchase and install information technology, a sound system,

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1 projectors and digital audio production equipment, including
2 related equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at the career
3 enrichment center in the Albuquerque public school district in
4 Bernalillo county;

5 29. fifty-five thousand dollars (\$55,000) to plan,
6 design, construct, improve, renovate and equip the grounds and
7 playgrounds, including landscaping, fencing and drainage, at
8 Carlos Rey elementary school in the Albuquerque public school
9 district in Bernalillo county;

10 30. forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) to purchase
11 and install information technology, including related
12 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at Carlos Rey
13 elementary school in the Albuquerque public school district in
14 Bernalillo county;

15 31. seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000) to purchase
16 and install security cameras and information technology,
17 including related furniture, equipment and infrastructure, at
18 Carlos Rey elementary school in the Albuquerque public school
19 district in Bernalillo county;

20 32. eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) to purchase
21 and install information technology, including related
22 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, and an awning at Cesar
23 Chavez community school in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

24 33. six thousand dollars (\$6,000) to plan, design,
25 equip and furnish Chamiza elementary school in the Albuquerque

1 public school district in Bernalillo county;

2 34. two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) to
3 purchase and install library equipment, furniture, information
4 technology and infrastructure at Chamiza elementary school in
5 the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo county;

6 35. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to
7 purchase and install information technology, including related
8 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at Chaparral
9 elementary school in the Albuquerque public school district in
10 Bernalillo county;

11 36. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to plan,
12 design, construct, renovate, improve and equip the grounds and
13 playgrounds, including fencing, drainage and landscaping, at
14 Chelwood elementary school in the Albuquerque public school
15 district in Bernalillo county;

16 37. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to
17 purchase and install library equipment, furniture, information
18 technology and infrastructure at Chelwood elementary school in
19 the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo county;

20 38. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to
21 purchase and install security cameras and information
22 technology, including related equipment, furniture and
23 infrastructure, at Chelwood elementary school in the

25 39. one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000)

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1 to plan, design, construct, renovate, equip and improve the

6 (\$125,000) to purchase and install library equipment,

11 purchase land and a building, to plan, design, construct,
12 renovate and equip facilities and to purchase and install

16 42. forty-three thousand dollars (\$43,000) to
17 purchase and install information technology, including related
18 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at Cleveland middle
19 school in the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo
20 county;

21 43. twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to purchase
22 and install information technology, including related
23 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at Cochiti elementary
24 school in the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo
25 county;

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1 44. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to
2 purchase and install information technology, a sound system and
3 projectors, including related equipment, furniture and
4 infrastructure, at Cochiti elementary school in the Albuquerque

16 SECTION 50. PROJECT SCOPE--EXPENDITURES.--If an

19 specified, the appropriation may be expended for any portion of
20 the purposes specified in the appropriation. Expenditures
21 shall not be made for purposes other than those specified in
22 the appropriation.

23 SECTION 52. ART IN PUBLIC PLACES.--Pursuant to Section
