10	(7) an assisted living center;
11	(8) a school-based health program;
12	(9) a mobile clinic;
13	(10) a mental health clinic;
14	(ll) a rehabilitation or other therapeutic
15	health setting;
16	(12) the patient's residence;
17	(13) a federally qualified health center; or

20	information, imaging and communication technologies, including
21	interactive audio, video, data communications as well as store-
22	and-forward technologies, to provide and support health care
