AN ACT

RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; CREATING THE FRONTIER
COMMUNITIES PROGRAM; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 3-60B-4 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1985,
Chapter 88, Section 4, as amended) is amended to read:

"3-60B-4. MAIN STREET PROGRAM--CREATED--COORDINATOR--
POWERS AND DUTIES.--

A. There is created the "main street program" in
the economic development department. The secretary of ~~the~~
economic development ~~department~~ shall employ a coordinator to
oversee the program.

B. The coordinator shall:

(1) carry out state responsibilities pursuant
to contract with the national main street center of the

18 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.--One hundred thousand dollars

19 (\$100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the

20 economic development department for expenditure in fiscal year

21 2013 for the main street program to develop a frontier

22 communities program. The frontier communities program shall

23 utilize the technical assistance, services and resources of the

24 main street program to establish a community economic

25 development partnership program tailored to the needs of

1 incorporated villages and towns with populations under five
2 thousand focused on their village plazas, squares and town
3 centers. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at
4 the end of fiscal year 2013 shall revert to the general fund.
