11 RELATING TO TAXATION; INCREASING A TEMPORARY DISTRIBUTION TO
12 MUNICIPALITIES AND COUNTIES; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 SECTION 1. Section 7-1-6.64 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2019,
16 Chapter 270, Section 9) is amended to read:

17 "7-1-6.64. DISTRIBUTION--MUNICIPALITIES AND COUNTIES.--

18 A. Beginning July 1, 2020 and prior to July 1,
19 2021, a distribution pursuant to Section 7-1-6.1 NMSA 1978
20 shall be made to municipalities from the net receipts
21 attributable to the gross receipts tax in an amount equal to
22 [~~one million two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$1,250,000)~~]
23 two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000). The
24 amount to be distributed to each municipality shall be in
25 proportion to the population of each municipality in the

1 proportion that the population of each municipality is to the
2 total population of all municipalities, according to the most
3 recent federal decennial census.

4 B. Beginning July 1, 2020 and prior to July 1,
5 2021, a distribution pursuant to Section 7-1-6.1 NMSA 1978
6 shall be made to counties from the net receipts attributable to
7 the gross receipts tax in an amount equal to [~~seven hundred~~
8 ~~fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000)~~] one million five hundred
9 thousand dollars (\$1,500,000). The amount to be distributed to
10 each county shall be in the proportion that the population of
11 each county is to the total population of all counties,
12 according to the most recent federal decennial census."

13 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public
14 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
