AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO FUND THE
FAMILY, INFANT, TODDLER PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--

A. Two million one hundred thousand dollars
(\$2,100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
department of health for expenditure in fiscal year 2013 to
fund the family, infant, toddler program in order to meet the
following goals:

(1) maintain the quality of early intervention
services for eligible children and their families and address
shortages in rural areas;

(2) cover the cost of early intervention
services and comply with increased requirements, federal and

1 state regulations and quality demands; and

2 (3) fund the projected shortfall in the
3 state's federal match for medicaid services.

4 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
5 at the end of fiscal year 2013 shall revert to the general
6 fund.
