AN ACT relating to government affairs; requiring a person who testifies before a governmental body and receives or expects to receive compensation for his or her testimony to state that fact before commencing such testimony; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

This bill prohibits any person who testifies before a governmental body and has received or reasonably expects to receive monetary compensation for his or her testimony from commencing such testimony before stating that fact clearly on the record.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** Chapter 237 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

- 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, a person who testifies before a governmental body and has received or reasonably expects to receive monetary compensation for his or her testimony shall not commence such testimony before stating that fact clearly on the record.
- 2. The provisions of subsection 1 do not apply to a person who testifies before a governmental body pursuant to subpoena and receives the same fees and mileage as are paid to witnesses in the courts of this State.





3. As used in this section:

(a) "Governmental body" means any administrative, advisory, executive or legislative body of the State or a local government including, without limitation, any board, commission, committee, subcommittee or other subsidiary thereof.

(b) "Person" means a natural person. The term includes, without limitation, a lobbyist as defined in NRS 218H.080.
