SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing the evidence satisfactory to declare status as a veteran on an instruction permit, driver’s license, identification card or commercial driver’s license. (BDR 43-242)

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AN ACT relating to veterans; revising provisions governing the evidence satisfactory to declare status as a veteran on an instruction permit, driver’s license, identification card and commercial driver’s license; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel’s Digest:**

1 Under existing law, the Department of Motor Vehicles is required to inquire of  
2 any applicant for an instruction permit, driver’s license, identification card or  
3 commercial driver’s license whether the person desires to declare that he or she is a  
4 veteran of the Armed Forces of the United States. (NRS 483.292, 483.852,  
5 483.927) If a person wishes to declare his or her status as a veteran, the person must  
6 provide evidence satisfactory to the Department that he or she has been honorably  
7 discharged from the Armed Forces of the United States. Such a person may also  
8 indicate to the Department whether or not the person wishes to have placed on his  
9 or her permit, license or card a designation that he or she is a veteran. (NRS  
10 483.2925, 483.853)

11 **Sections 1-3** of this bill provide that such evidence may include, without  
12 limitation, digital verification obtained from the Nevada Veterans Information  
13 System maintained by the Department of Veterans Services.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** NRS 483.292 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2       483.292 1. When a person applies to the Department for the  
3 initial issuance of an instruction permit or driver's license pursuant  
4 to NRS 483.290 or 483.291 or the renewal of an instruction permit  
5 or driver's license, the Department shall inquire whether the person  
6 desires to declare that he or she is a veteran of the Armed Forces of  
7 the United States.

8       2. If the person desires to declare pursuant to subsection 1 that  
9 he or she is a veteran of the Armed Forces of the United States, the  
10 person shall provide:

11       (a) Evidence satisfactory to the Department that he or she has  
12 been honorably discharged from the Armed Forces of the United  
13 States; and

14       (b) A written release authorizing the Department of Motor  
15 Vehicles to provide to the Department of Veterans Services personal  
16 information about the person, which release must be signed by the  
17 person and in a form required by the Director pursuant to  
18 NRS 481.063.

19       3. In addition to the declaration described in subsection 1, a  
20 person who is a veteran of the Armed Forces of the United States  
21 and who wishes to have placed on his or her instruction permit or  
22 driver's license a designation that he or she is a veteran, as described  
23 in NRS 483.2925, must:

24       (a) If applying for the initial issuance of an instruction permit or  
25 driver's license, appear in person at an office of the Department and  
26 submit evidence satisfactory to the Department that ~~[the person]~~ *he*  
27 *or she* has been honorably discharged from the Armed Forces of the  
28 United States.

29       (b) If applying for the renewal of an instruction permit or  
30 driver's license upon which a designation that the person is a  
31 veteran:

32       (1) Is not placed, submit by mail or in person an honorable  
33 discharge or other document of honorable separation from the  
34 Armed Forces of the United States ~~or~~ *or other evidence satisfactory*  
35 *to the Department that he or she has been honorably discharged*  
36 *from the Armed Forces of the United States.*

37       (2) Is placed, submit by mail, in person or by other means  
38 authorized by the Department a statement that the person wishes the  
39 instruction permit or driver's license to continue to designate that  
40 the person is a veteran.

41       4. The Department shall, at least once each month:



1 (a) Compile a list of persons who have, during the immediately  
2 preceding month, declared pursuant to subsection 1 that they are  
3 veterans of the Armed Forces of the United States; and

4 (b) Transmit that list to the Department of Veterans Services to  
5 be used for statistical and communication purposes.

6 *5. As used in this section, "evidence satisfactory to the*  
7 *Department that he or she has been honorably discharged from*  
8 *the Armed Forces of the United States" includes, without*  
9 *limitation, digital verification obtained from the Nevada Veterans*  
10 *Information System, or its successor, maintained by the*  
11 *Department of Veterans Services.*

12 **Sec. 2.** NRS 483.852 is hereby amended to read as follows:

13 483.852 1. When a person applies to the Department for the  
14 initial issuance of an identification card pursuant to NRS 483.850 or  
15 the renewal of an identification card pursuant to NRS 483.875, the  
16 Department shall inquire whether the person desires to declare that  
17 he or she is a veteran of the Armed Forces of the United States.

18 2. If the person desires to declare pursuant to subsection 1 that  
19 he or she is a veteran of the Armed Forces of the United States, the  
20 person shall provide:

21 (a) Evidence satisfactory to the Department that he or she has  
22 been honorably discharged from the Armed Forces of the United  
23 States; and

24 (b) A written release authorizing the Department of Motor  
25 Vehicles to provide to the Department of Veterans Services personal  
26 information about the person, which release must be signed  
27 by the person and in a form required by the Director pursuant to  
28 NRS 481.063.

29 3. In addition to the declaration described in subsection 1, a  
30 person who is a veteran of the Armed Forces of the United States  
31 and who wishes to have placed on his or her identification card a  
32 designation that he or she is a veteran, as described in NRS 483.853,  
33 must:

34 (a) If applying for the initial issuance of an identification card,  
35 appear in person at an office of the Department and submit evidence  
36 satisfactory to the Department that ~~{the person}~~ *he or she* has been  
37 honorably discharged from the Armed Forces of the United States.

38 (b) If applying for the renewal of an identification card upon  
39 which a designation that the person is a veteran:

40 (1) Is not placed, submit by mail or in person an honorable  
41 discharge or other document of honorable separation from the  
42 Armed Forces of the United States ~~{}~~ *or other evidence satisfactory*  
43 *to the Department that he or she has been honorably discharged*  
44 *from the Armed Forces of the United States.*



1 (2) Is placed, submit by mail, in person or by other means  
2 authorized by the Department a statement that the person wishes the  
3 identification card to continue to designate that the person is a  
4 veteran.

5 4. The Department shall, at least once each month:

6 (a) Compile a list of persons who have, during the immediately  
7 preceding month, declared pursuant to subsection 1 that they are  
8 veterans of the Armed Forces of the United States; and

9 (b) Transmit that list to the Department of Veterans Services to  
10 be used for statistical and communication purposes.

11 ***5. As used in this section, "evidence satisfactory to the***  
12 ***Department that he or she has been honorably discharged from***  
13 ***the Armed Forces of the United States" includes, without***  
14 ***limitation, digital verification obtained from the Nevada Veterans***  
15 ***Information System, or its successor, maintained by the***  
16 ***Department of Veterans Services.***

17 **Sec. 3.** NRS 483.927 is hereby amended to read as follows:

18 483.927 1. A person who wishes to have placed on his or her  
19 commercial driver's license a designation that he or she is a veteran  
20 of the Armed Forces of the United States pursuant to subsection 2  
21 must:

22 (a) If applying for the initial issuance of a commercial driver's  
23 license, appear in person at an office of the Department and submit  
24 evidence satisfactory to the Department that ~~the person~~ ***he or she***  
25 ***has been honorably discharged from the Armed Forces of the United***  
26 ***States.***

27 (b) If applying for the renewal of a commercial driver's license  
28 upon which a designation that the person is a veteran:

29 (1) Is not placed, submit by mail or in person an honorable  
30 discharge or other document of honorable separation from the  
31 Armed Forces of the United States ~~+~~ ***or other evidence satisfactory***  
32 ***to the Department that he or she has been honorably discharged***  
33 ***from the Armed Forces of the United States.***

34 (2) Is placed, submit by mail, in person or by other means  
35 authorized by the Department a statement that the person wishes the  
36 commercial driver's license to continue to designate that the person  
37 is a veteran.

38 2. Upon the request of a person that his or her commercial  
39 driver's license indicate that he or she is a veteran of the Armed  
40 Forces of the United States pursuant to subsection 1, and who  
41 satisfies the requirements of that subsection, the Department shall  
42 place on any commercial driver's license issued to the person  
43 pursuant to the provisions of this chapter a designation that the  
44 person is a veteran.



1 3. The Director shall determine the design and placement of the  
2 designation of veteran status required by this section on any  
3 commercial driver's license to which this section applies.

4 *4. As used in this section, "evidence satisfactory to the*  
5 *Department that he or she has been honorably discharged from*  
6 *the Armed Forces of the United States" includes, without*  
7 *limitation, digital verification obtained from the Nevada Veterans*  
8 *Information System, or its successor, maintained by the*  
9 *Department of Veterans Services.*

10 **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective:

11 1. Upon passage and approval for the purposes of adopting any  
12 regulations and performing any other preparatory administrative  
13 tasks that are necessary to carry out the provisions of this act; and

14 2. On July 1, 2019, for all other purposes.
