AN ACT relating to education; revising provisions relating to the salaries of teachers; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 This bill provides that before a teacher may receive credit on the schedule of
2 salaries for a specific level of education acquired by the teacher, the teacher is
3 required to apply to the board of trustees of the school district for approval. This
4 bill requires the board of trustees to approve the teacher to receive credit on the
5 schedule of salaries for the specific level of education if the subject area of the
6 course or courses is related to the subject area taught by the teacher.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 391 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 ***1. Before a teacher may receive credit on the schedule of
4 salaries of the school district for a specific level of education
5 acquired by the teacher, the teacher must apply to the board of
6 trustees for the approval of the school district.***

7 ***2. A board of trustees shall approve a teacher to receive credit
8 on the schedule of salaries of the school district for a specific level
9 of education acquired by the teacher if the subject area of the
10 course or courses is related to the subject area taught by the
11 teacher.***

1 ***3. The provisions of this section must be included in any
2 agreement or contract negotiated pursuant to chapter 288 of NRS
3 between the board of trustees of the school district and the
4 recognized employee organization that represents licensed
5 educational personnel within the school district.***

6 **Sec. 2.** The provisions of section 1 of this act do not apply to
7 any collective bargaining agreement entered into pursuant to chapter
8 288 of NRS before July 1, 2013, during the current term of the
9 agreement, but do apply to any extension or renewal of such an
10 agreement and to any collective bargaining agreement entered into
11 on or after July 1, 2013.

12 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2013.
