AN ACT making an appropriation to the State Public Works Board of the State Public Works Division of the Department of Administration for the advance planning and schematic design phases on a master plan for the Reno-Sparks Livestock Events Center; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General  
2 Fund to the State Public Works Board of the State Public Works  
3 Division of the Department of Administration the sum of  
4 \$1,500,000 for the advance planning and schematic design phases  
5 on a master plan to rehabilitate, repair, renovate and improve the  
6 Reno-Sparks Livestock Events Center.

7     **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by  
8 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after  
9 June 30, 2021, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or  
10 any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or  
11 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the  
12 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose  
13 after September 17, 2021, by either the entity to which the money  
14 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently



1 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General  
2 Fund on or before September 17, 2021.

3 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2019.
