

SENATE BILL NO. 485—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE
(ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION)

SUMMARY—Appropriates to and authorizes the expenditure of money by the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services of the Department of Health and Human Services for the integration of eligibility rules for the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families program and the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program into the eligibility system. (BDR S-1180)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services of the Department of Health and Human Services for the integration of eligibility rules for the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families program and the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program into the eligibility system; authorizing the Division to expend certain other money for the same purpose; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
- 2 Fund to the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services of the
- 3 Department of Health and Human Services the sum of \$452,100 for
- 4 the integration of eligibility rules for the Temporary Assistance for
- 5 Needy Families program and the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance
- 6 Program into the eligibility system.



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1 **Sec. 2.** Expenditure of the sum of \$10,547,900 not
2 appropriated from the State General Fund or the State Highway
3 Fund is hereby authorized during the fiscal years beginning on
4 July 1, 2013, and ending on June 30, 2015, by the Division of
5 Welfare and Supportive Services of the Department of Health and
6 Human Services for the integration of eligibility rules for the
7 Temporary Assistance for Needy Families program and the
8 Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program into the eligibility
9 system.

10 **Sec. 3.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
11 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
12 June 30, 2015, by the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services
13 of the Department of Health and Human Services or any entity to
14 which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise
15 transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated
16 money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after
17 September 18, 2015, by either the Division of Welfare and
18 Supportive Services or the entity to which the money was
19 subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the
20 State General Fund on or before September 18, 2015.

21 **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
