SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION—Proposing to amend the Nevada
Constitution to provide certain rights to voters.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 Existing law provides voters with certain rights. (NRS 293.2546) This
2 resolution proposes to amend the Nevada Constitution by adding a new section to
3 Article 2 to provide those rights in the Nevada Constitution.

1 RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF
2 NEVADA, JOINTLY, That a new section, designated Section 1A, be
3 added to Article 2 of the Nevada Constitution to read as follows:

4 *Sec. 1A. Each voter has the right:*

5 *1. To receive and cast a ballot that:*

6 *(a) Is written in a format that allows the clear*
7 *identification of candidates; and*

8 *(b) Accurately records the voter’s preference in the*
9 *selection of candidates.*

10 *2. To have questions concerning voting procedures*
11 *answered and to have an explanation of the procedures for*
12 *voting posted in a conspicuous place at the polling place.*



- 1 3. *To vote without being intimidated, threatened or*
2 *coerced.*
- 3 4. *To vote on election day if the voter is waiting in line*
4 *at his or her polling place to vote at the time that the polls*
5 *close and the voter has not already cast a vote in that*
6 *election.*
- 7 5. *To return a spoiled ballot and receive another ballot*
8 *in its place.*
- 9 6. *To request assistance in voting, if necessary.*
- 10 7. *To a sample ballot which is accurate, informative*
11 *and delivered in a timely manner.*
- 12 8. *To receive instruction in the use of the equipment*
13 *for voting during any period for early voting or on election*
14 *day.*
- 15 9. *To equal access to the elections system without*
16 *discrimination, including, without limitation, discrimination*
17 *on the basis of race, age, disability, employment or overseas*
18 *residence.*
- 19 10. *To a uniform, statewide standard for counting and*
20 *recounting all votes accurately.*
- 21 11. *To have complaints about elections and election*
22 *contests resolved fairly, accurately and efficiently.*
