SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION—Urging Congress to grant additional school trust lands to Nevada.

WHEREAS, Early in our nation's history, the Federal Government expressed support for public education by granting school trust lands to every state and establishing corresponding permanent school funds; and

WHEREAS, The money earned from these school trust lands was required to be put into trust funds to support public education in lieu of taxes; and

WHEREAS, Nevada received approximately 2,000,000 acres in school trust lands, while the surrounding states of Arizona, New Mexico and Utah received over 7,500,000 acres; and

WHEREAS, Fewer than 3,000 acres remain of the original 2,000,000 acres of school trust lands granted to the State of Nevada; and

WHEREAS, An additional grant of at least 4,000,000 acres of public lands from Congress to this State is required to give the State of Nevada parity with the surrounding states of Arizona, New Mexico and Utah; and

WHEREAS, Nevada's pupils and students have not realized the full benefit of the school trust lands; and

WHEREAS, Revenue from the school trust lands will help improve funding for education and support a system in need of additional resources without raising taxes; and

WHEREAS, Such additional resources will help improve the quality of education in the State of Nevada and provide greater opportunities for Nevada's pupils and students; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, JOINTLY, That the 81st Session of the Nevada Legislature urges Congress to grant additional school trust lands to Nevada in order to achieve parity with surrounding states and provide the maximum benefit to the pupils and students in Nevada's public schools; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Senate prepare and transmit a copy of this resolution to the Vice President of the United States as the presiding officer of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives and each member of the Nevada Congressional Delegation; and be it further

RESOLVED, That this resolution becomes effective upon passage.
