H.B. 71 (As Introduced)	Sub. H.B. 71 (I_135_3090-5)
<b>Eligibility or application requirements for the director</b>	
Requires that the director have experience in job placement, guidance counseling, and primary and secondary education ( <i>R.C. 3301.25 (B)(2)</i> ).	Same, but: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Changes guidance counseling to <i>school</i> counseling; and</li> <li>2. Requires the experience to be in job placement, school counseling, <i>or</i> primary and secondary education (<i>R.C. 3301.25 (B)(2)</i>).</li> </ol>
<b>Soft skills and professional skills training</b>	
Requires a director to offer instruction in soft skills and professional skills training and, if a district or school currently offers similar instruction, to collaborate with those instructors ( <i>R.C. 3301.25(C)(4)</i> ).	Same, but requires a director also to collaborate with other appropriate school officials that have commensurate experience and professionals who support career development in the school ( <i>R.C. 3301.25(C)(4)</i> ).
