| To enact sections 4723.489, 4729.282, 4730.432, and | 1 |

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

| Section 1. That sections 4723.489, 4729.282, 4730.432, and | 6 |
