To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section
4503.555 of the Revised Code to create the
"Street Rod" license plate.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4501.21 be amended and section
4503.555 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 4501.21. (A) There is hereby created in the state
treasury the license plate contribution fund. The fund shall
consist of all contributions paid by motor vehicle registrants
and collected by the registrar of motor vehicles pursuant to
sections 4503.491, 4503.492, 4503.493, 4503.494, 4503.496,
4503.498, 4503.499, 4503.50, 4503.501, 4503.502, 4503.505,
4503.51, 4503.522, 4503.523, 4503.524, 4503.525, 4503.526,
4503.531, 4503.534, 4503.545, 4503.55, 4503.551, 4503.552,
4503.553, 4503.554, 4503.561, 4503.562, 4503.564, 4503.576,
4503.591, 4503.67, 4503.68, 4503.69, 4503.701, 4503.71,
4503.711, 4503.712, 4503.713, 4503.72, 4503.73, 4503.732,
4503.74, 4503.75, 4503.751, 4503.85, 4503.89, 4503.90, 4503.92,
and 4503.94 of the Revised Code.

(B) The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar collects in the fund as follows:

The registrar shall pay the contributions received pursuant to section 4503.491 of the Revised Code to the breast cancer fund of Ohio, which shall use that money only to pay for programs that provide assistance and education to Ohio breast cancer patients and that improve access for such patients to quality health care and clinical trials and shall not use any of the money for abortion information, counseling, services, or other abortion-related activities.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.492 of the Revised Code to the organization cancer support community central Ohio, which shall deposit the money into the Sheryl L. Kraner Fund of that organization. Cancer support community central Ohio shall expend the money it receives pursuant to this division only in the same manner and for the same purposes as that organization expends other money in that fund.

The registrar shall pay the contributions received pursuant to section 4503.493 of the Revised Code to the autism society of Ohio, which shall use the contributions for programs and autism awareness efforts throughout the state.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.494 of the Revised Code to the national multiple sclerosis society for distribution in equal amounts to the northwestern Ohio, Ohio buckeye, and Ohio valley chapters of the national multiple sclerosis society. These chapters shall use the money they receive under this section to assist in paying the expenses they incur in providing services directly to their clients.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.496 of the Revised Code to the Ohio sickle cell and health association, which shall use the contributions to help support educational, clinical, and social support services for adults who have sickle cell disease.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.498 of the Revised Code to special olympics Ohio, inc., which shall use the contributions for its programs, charitable efforts, and other activities.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.499 of the Revised Code to the children's glioma cancer foundation, which shall use the contributions for its research and other programs.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.50 of the Revised Code to the future farmers of America foundation, which shall deposit the contributions into its general account to be used for educational and scholarship purposes of the future farmers of America foundation.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.501 of the Revised Code to the 4-H youth development program of the Ohio state university extension program, which shall use those contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in conducting its educational activities.

The registrar shall pay the contributions received pursuant to section 4503.502 of the Revised Code to the Ohio cattlemen's foundation, which shall use those contributions for scholarships and other educational activities.

The registrar shall pay the contributions received

pursuant to section 4503.505 of the Revised Code to the 78
organization Ohio region phi theta kappa, which shall use those 79
contributions for scholarships for students who are members of 80
that organization. 81

The registrar shall pay each contribution the registrar 82
receives pursuant to section 4503.51 of the Revised Code to the 83
university or college whose name or marking or design appears on 84
collegiate license plates that are issued to a person under that 85
section. A university or college that receives contributions 86
from the fund shall deposit the contributions into its general 87
scholarship fund. 88

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 89
receives pursuant to section 4503.522 of the Revised Code to the 90
"friends of Perry's victory and international peace memorial, 91
incorporated," a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws 92
of this state, to assist that organization in paying the 93
expenses it incurs in sponsoring or holding charitable, 94
educational, and cultural events at the monument. 95

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 96
receives pursuant to section 4503.523 of the Revised Code to the 97
fairport lights foundation, which shall use the money to pay for 98
the restoration, maintenance, and preservation of the 99
lighthouses of fairport harbor. 100

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 101
receives pursuant to section 4503.524 of the Revised Code to the 102
Massillon tiger football booster club, which shall use the 103
contributions only to promote and support the football team of 104
Washington high school of the Massillon city school district. 105

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 106

receives pursuant to section 4503.525 of the Revised Code to the 107
United States power squadron districts seven, eleven, twenty- 108
four, and twenty-nine in equal amounts. Each power squadron 109
district shall use the money it receives under this section to 110
pay for the educational boating programs each district holds or 111
sponsors within this state. 112

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 113
receives pursuant to section 4503.526 of the Revised Code to the 114
Ohio district Kiwanis foundation of the Ohio district of Kiwanis 115
international, which shall use the money it receives under this 116
section to pay the costs of its educational and humanitarian 117
activities. 118

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 119
receives pursuant to section 4503.531 of the Revised Code to the 120
thank you foundation, incorporated, a nonprofit corporation 121
organized under the laws of this state, to assist that 122
organization in paying for the charitable activities and 123
programs it sponsors in support of United States military 124
personnel, veterans, and their families. 125

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 126
receives pursuant to section 4503.534 of the Revised Code to the 127
disabled American veterans department of Ohio, to be used for 128
programs that serve disabled American veterans and their 129
families. 130

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 131
receives pursuant to section 4503.55 of the Revised Code to the 132
pro football hall of fame, which shall deposit the contributions 133
into a special bank account that it establishes and which shall 134
be separate and distinct from any other account the pro football 135
hall of fame maintains, to be used exclusively for the purpose 136

of promoting the pro football hall of fame as a travel 137
destination. 138

The registrar shall pay the contributions that are paid to 139
the registrar pursuant to section 4503.545 of the Revised Code 140
to the national rifle association foundation, which shall use 141
the money to pay the costs of the educational activities and 142
programs the foundation holds or sponsors in this state. 143

The registrar shall pay to the Ohio pet fund the 144
contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 145
4503.551 of the Revised Code and any other money from any other 146
source, including donations, gifts, and grants, that is 147
designated by the source to be paid to the Ohio pet fund. The 148
Ohio pet fund shall use the moneys it receives under this 149
section to support programs for the sterilization of dogs and 150
cats and for educational programs concerning the proper 151
veterinary care of those animals, and for expenses of the Ohio 152
pet fund that are reasonably necessary for it to obtain and 153
maintain its tax-exempt status and to perform its duties. 154

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 155
receives pursuant to section 4503.552 of the Revised Code to the 156
rock and roll hall of fame and museum, incorporated. 157

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 158
receives pursuant to section 4503.553 of the Revised Code to the 159
Ohio coalition for animals, incorporated, a nonprofit 160
corporation. Except as provided in division (B) of this section, 161
the coalition shall distribute the money to its members, and the 162
members shall use the money only to pay for educational, 163
charitable, and other programs of each coalition member that 164
provide care for unwanted, abused, and neglected horses. The 165
Ohio coalition for animals may use a portion of the money to pay 166

for reasonable marketing costs incurred in the design and 167
promotion of the license plate and for administrative costs 168
incurred in the disbursement and management of funds received 169
under this section. 170

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 171
receives pursuant to section 4503.554 of the Revised Code to the 172
Ohio state council of the knights of Columbus, which shall use 173
the contributions to pay for its charitable activities and 174
programs. 175

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 176
receives pursuant to section 4503.555 of the Revised Code to the 177
western reserve historical society, which shall use the 178
contributions to fund the crawford auto aviation museum. 179

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 180
receives pursuant to section 4503.561 of the Revised Code to the 181
state of Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., which shall 182
deposit the contributions into a special bank account that it 183
establishes. The special bank account shall be separate and 184
distinct from any other account the state of Ohio chapter of 185
ducks unlimited, inc., maintains and shall be used exclusively 186
for the purpose of protecting, enhancing, restoring, and 187
managing wetlands and conserving wildlife habitat. The state of 188
Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., annually shall notify the 189
registrar in writing of the name, address, and account to which 190
such payments are to be made. 191

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 192
receives pursuant to section 4503.562 of the Revised Code to the 193
Mahoning river consortium, which shall use the money to pay the 194
expenses it incurs in restoring and maintaining the Mahoning 195
river watershed. 196

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.564 of the Revised Code to Antioch college for the use of the Glen Helen ecology institute to pay expenses related to the Glen Helen nature preserve.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.576 of the Revised Code to the Ohio state beekeepers association, which shall use those contributions to promote beekeeping, provide educational information about beekeeping, and to support other state and local beekeeping programs.

The registrar shall pay to a sports commission created pursuant to section 4503.591 of the Revised Code each contribution the registrar receives under that section that an applicant pays to obtain license plates that bear the logo of a professional sports team located in the county of that sports commission and that is participating in the license plate program pursuant to division (E) of that section, irrespective of the county of residence of an applicant.

The registrar shall pay to a community charity each contribution the registrar receives under section 4503.591 of the Revised Code that an applicant pays to obtain license plates that bear the logo of a professional sports team that is participating in the license plate program pursuant to division (G) of that section.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.67 of the Revised Code to the Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.68 of the Revised Code to the great river council of the girl scouts of the United States of America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner throughout the state to regional councils of the girl scouts.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.69 of the Revised Code to the Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.701 of the Revised Code to the Prince Hall grand lodge of free and accepted masons of Ohio, which shall use the contributions for scholarship purposes.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.71 of the Revised Code to the fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall deposit the fees into its general account to be used for purposes of the fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.711 of the Revised Code to the fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall deposit the contributions into an account that it creates to be used for the purpose of advancing and protecting the law enforcement profession, promoting improved law enforcement methods, and teaching respect for law and order.

The registrar shall pay the contributions received pursuant to section 4503.712 of the Revised Code to Ohio

concerns of police survivors, which shall use those 255
contributions to provide whatever assistance may be appropriate 256
to the families of Ohio law enforcement officers who are killed 257
in the line of duty. 258

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 259
pursuant to section 4503.713 of the Revised Code to the greater 260
Cleveland peace officers memorial society, which shall use those 261
contributions to honor law enforcement officers who have died in 262
the line of duty and support its charitable purposes. 263

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 264
receives pursuant to section 4503.72 of the Revised Code to the 265
organization known on March 31, 2003, as the Ohio CASA/GAL 266
association, a private, nonprofit corporation organized under 267
Chapter 1702. of the Revised Code. The Ohio CASA/GAL association 268
shall use these contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in 269
administering a program to secure the proper representation in 270
the courts of this state of abused, neglected, and dependent 271
children, and for the training and supervision of persons 272
participating in that program. 273

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 274
receives pursuant to section 4503.73 of the Revised Code to 275
Wright B. Flyer, incorporated, which shall deposit the 276
contributions into its general account to be used for purposes 277
of Wright B. Flyer, incorporated. 278

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 279
receives pursuant to section 4503.732 of the Revised Code to the 280
Siegel & Shuster society, a nonprofit organization dedicated to 281
commemorating and celebrating the creation of Superman in 282
Cleveland, Ohio. 283

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.74 of the Revised Code to the Columbus zoological park association, which shall disburse the moneys to Ohio's major metropolitan zoos, as defined in section 4503.74 of the Revised Code, in accordance with a written agreement entered into by the major metropolitan zoos.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.75 of the Revised Code to the rotary foundation, located on March 31, 2003, in Evanston, Illinois, to be placed in a fund known as the permanent fund and used to endow educational and humanitarian programs of the rotary foundation.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.751 of the Revised Code to the Ohio association of realtors, which shall deposit the contributions into a property disaster relief fund maintained under the Ohio realtors charitable and education foundation.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.85 of the Revised Code to the Ohio sea grant college program to be used for Lake Erie area research projects.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.89 of the Revised Code to the American red cross of greater Columbus on behalf of the Ohio chapters of the American red cross, which shall use the contributions for disaster readiness, preparedness, and response programs on a statewide basis.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.90 of the Revised Code to the

nationwide children's hospital foundation. 313

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 314
pursuant to section 4503.92 of the Revised Code to support our 315
troops, incorporated, a national nonprofit corporation, which 316
shall use those contributions in accordance with its articles of 317
incorporation and for the benefit of servicemembers of the armed 318
forces of the United States and their families when they are in 319
financial need. 320

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 321
receives pursuant to section 4503.94 of the Revised Code to the 322
Michelle's leading star foundation, which shall use the money 323
solely to fund the rental, lease, or purchase of the simulated 324
driving curriculum of the Michelle's leading star foundation by 325
boards of education of city, exempted village, local, and joint 326
vocational school districts. 327

(C) All investment earnings of the license plate 328
contribution fund shall be credited to the fund. Not later than 329
the first day of May of every year, the registrar shall 330
distribute to each entity described in division (B) of this 331
section the investment income the fund earned the previous 332
calendar year. The amount of such a distribution paid to an 333
entity shall be proportionate to the amount of money the entity 334
received from the fund during the previous calendar year. 335

Sec. 4503.555. (A) The owner or lessee of any passenger 336
car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other 337
vehicle of a class approved by the registrar of motor vehicles 338
may apply to the registrar for the registration of the vehicle 339
and issuance of street rod license plates. The application for 340
street rod license plates may be combined with a request for a 341
special reserved license plate under section 4503.40 or 4503.42 342

of the Revised Code. Upon receipt of the completed application 343
and compliance with division (B) of this section, the registrar 344
shall issue to the applicant the appropriate vehicle 345
registration and a set of street rod license plates with a 346
validation sticker, or a validation sticker alone when required 347
by section 4503.191 of the Revised Code. 348

In addition to the letters and numbers ordinarily 349
inscribed thereon, street rod license plates shall be inscribed 350
with words and markings selected and designed by the western 351
reserve historical society and approved by the registrar. Street 352
rod license plates shall bear county identification stickers 353
that identify the county of registration by name or number. 354

(B) Street rod license plates and validation stickers 355
shall be issued upon payment of the regular license tax as 356
prescribed under section 4503.04 of the Revised Code, any 357
applicable motor vehicle tax levied under Chapter 4504. of the 358
Revised Code, a bureau of motor vehicles administrative fee of 359
ten dollars, the contribution specified in division (C) of this 360
section, and compliance with all other applicable laws relating 361
to the registration of motor vehicles. If the application for 362
street rod license plates is combined with a request for a 363
special reserved license plate under section 4503.40 or 4503.42 364
of the Revised Code, the license plates and validation sticker 365
shall be issued upon payment of the contribution, fees, and 366
taxes contained in this division and the additional fee 367
prescribed under section 4503.40 or 4503.42 of the Revised Code. 368

(C) For each application for registration and registration 369
renewal submitted under this section, the registrar shall 370
collect a contribution of fifteen dollars. The registrar shall 371
pay this contribution into the state treasury to the credit of 372

the license plate contribution fund created in section 4501.21 373
of the Revised Code. 374

The registrar shall pay the ten-dollar bureau 375
administrative fee, the purpose of which is to compensate the 376
bureau for additional services required in issuing street rod 377
license plates, into the state treasury to the credit of the 378
state bureau of motor vehicles fund created in section 4501.25 379
of the Revised Code. 380

Section 2. That existing section 4501.21 of the Revised 381
Code is hereby repealed. 382

Section 3. Section 4501.21 of the Revised Code is 383
presented in this act as a composite of the section as amended 384
by Am. Sub. H.B. 23, Sub. H.B. 206, Am. H.B. 474, and Am. S.B. 385
186, all of the 130th General Assembly. The General Assembly, 386
applying the principle stated in division (B) of section 1.52 of 387
the Revised Code that amendments are to be harmonized if 388
reasonably capable of simultaneous operation, finds that the 389
composite is the resulting version of the section in effect 390
prior to the effective date of the section as presented in this 391
act. 392
