**A BILL**

To enact section 5534.433 of the Revised Code to 1  
designate a portion of State Route 123 in Warren 2  
County as the "Officer Ciera N. Greene Memorial 3  
Highway." 4

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That section 5534.433 of the Revised Code be 5  
enacted to read as follows: 6

**Sec. 5534.433.** In addition to any other name prescribed in 7  
the Revised Code or otherwise, the portion of state route number 8  
one hundred twenty-three, running in a northwesterly and 9  
southeasterly direction between the intersection of that route 10  
and interstate route number seventy-one and the eastern border 11  
of the municipal corporation of Lebanon, in Warren county, shall 12  
be known as the "Officer Ciera N. Greene Memorial Highway." 13

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 14  
along the highway indicating its name. 15
