A BILL

To repeal section 4121.351 of the Revised Code to
eliminate the ability of the Industrial Commission
to enter into personal service contracts during
hearing spikes, to make appropriations for the
Industrial Commission for the biennium beginning
July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017, and to
provide authorization and conditions for the
operation of Commission programs.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4121.351 of the Revised Code is
hereby repealed.

Section 2. All items in this section are hereby appropriated
out of any moneys in the state treasury to the credit of the
designated fund. For all appropriations made in this section,
those in the first column are for fiscal year 2016, and those in
the second column are for fiscal year 2017.

The foregoing appropriation item 845402, Rent - William Green Building, shall be used for rent and operating expenses for the space occupied by the Industrial Commission in the William Green Building. 27
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Section 3. Law contained in the main operating appropriations act of the 131st General Assembly that applies generally to the appropriations made in that act also applies generally to the appropriations made in this act. 31
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Section 4. The provisions of law contained in this act, and their applications, are severable. If any provision of law contained in this act, or if any application of any provision of law contained in this act, is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions of law contained in this act and their applications that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application. 35
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Section 5. Except as otherwise specifically provided in this act, the sections of law contained in this act, and the items of law of which the sections of law contained in this act are composed, are not subject to the referendum under Ohio Constitution, Article II, Section 1d and section 1.471 of the Revised Code and therefore go into immediate effect when this act becomes law. 42
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Section 6. The amendment, enactment, or repeal by this act of 49
the divisions and sections of law listed below are subject to the 50
referendum under Ohio Constitution, Article II, Section 1c and 51
therefore take effect on the ninety-first day after this act is 52
filed with the Secretary of State: 53
