AN ACT

To enact section 5.2299 of the Revised Code to designate the second week of September as "Krabbe Disease Awareness Week."

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That section 5.2299 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 5.2299. The second week of September is designated as "Krabbe Disease Awareness Week" to raise awareness of Krabbe disease, also known as globoid cell leukodystrophy, which is a life-threatening, inherited disorder that destroys the protective coating of nerve cells in the brain and nervous system, typically resulting in complications that include seizures, muscle spasms, muscle deterioration, blindness, deafness, and respiratory failure.
