A RESOLUTION

Relative to the election of Kevin D. Miller to fill the 1
vacancy in the membership of the House of 2
Representatives created by the expulsion of Larry 3
Householder of the 72nd House District. 4

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF
OHIO:**

WHEREAS, Section 11 of Article II of the Ohio Constitution 5
provides for the filling of a vacancy in the membership of the House 6
of Representatives by election by the members of the House of 7
Representatives who are affiliated with the same political party as 8
the person last elected to the seat which has become vacant; and 9

WHEREAS, Larry Householder of the 72nd House District, was 10
expelled from the House of Representatives of the 134th General 11
Assembly, pursuant to House Resolution No. 69 - and Article II, 12
Section 6, of the Ohio Constitution - on June 16, 2021, thus creating 13
a vacancy in the House of Representatives; therefore be it 14

RESOLVED, By the members of the House of Representatives who are 15
affiliated with the Republican party that Kevin D. Miller, Republican, 16
having the qualifications set forth in the Ohio Constitution and the 17
laws of Ohio to be a member of the House of Representatives from the 18
72nd House District, is hereby elected, effective June 28, 2021, 19
pursuant to Section 11 of Article II of the Ohio Constitution, as a 20
member of the House of Representatives from the 72nd House District, 21
to fill the vacancy created by the unexpired portion of the term of 22
said Larry Householder, ending on December 31, 2022; and be it further 23

RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be spread upon the pages 24
of the Journal of the House of Representatives together with the yeas 25
and nays of the members of the House of Representatives affiliated 26
with the Republican party voting on the resolution, and that the Clerk 27
of the House of Representatives shall certify the resolution and vote 28
on its adoption to the Secretary of State. 29
