A BILL

To enact section 5.2298 of the Revised Code to 1
designate October 16 as George Washington 2
Williams day. 3

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5.2298 of the Revised Code be 4
enacted to read as follows: 5

Sec. 5.2298. The sixteenth day of October is designated as 6
George Washington Williams day in commemoration of the civil war 7
veteran, minister, politician, lawyer, and historian who was 8
born on that day in 1849. Elementary and secondary schools in 9
the state are encouraged to observe this day by discussing the 10
life of George Washington Williams. 11
