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A BILL

To amend section 5533.359 and to enact sections 1
5534.012, 5534.15 to 5534.17, 5534.19 to 2
5534.24, 5534.26 to 5534.36, 5534.43, 5534.50 to 3
5534.52, 5534.55, 5534.70, and 5534.71 of the 4
Revised Code to designate various bridges and 5
highways. 6

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5533.359 be amended and sections 7
5534.012, 5534.15, 5534.16, 5534.17, 5534.19, 5534.20, 5534.21, 8
5534.22, 5534.23, 5534.24, 5534.26, 5534.27, 5534.28, 5534.29, 9
5534.30, 5534.31, 5534.32, 5534.33, 5534.34, 5534.35, 5534.36, 10

5534.43, 5534.50, 5534.51, 5534.52, 5534.55, 5534.70, and 11
5534.71 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows: 12

Sec. 5533.359. In addition to the designation in section 13
5533.35 of the Revised Code, both the bridge eastbound and 14
westbound bridges that will span the Cuyahoga river in Cuyahoga 15
county ~~that and~~ will be part of the highway known as interstate 16
route number ninety ~~and having an approximate scheduled~~ 17
~~completion date of late 2016 or early 2017~~ shall be known as the 18
"George V. Voinovich Bridge." 19

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 20
~~along upon the bridge bridges or its along their~~ approaches 21
indicating ~~its~~ their name. 22

Sec. 5534.012. In addition to any other name prescribed in 23
the Revised Code or otherwise, that portion of the road known as 24
United States route number one hundred twenty-seven, commencing 25
at the northern edge of the municipal corporation of Paulding 26
and proceeding in a northerly direction to the intersection of 27
that route with state route number one hundred eleven in 28
Paulding county, shall be known as the "U.S. Navy Petty Officer 29
2nd Class Randall Smith Memorial Highway." 30

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 31
along the highway indicating its name. 32

Sec. 5534.15. In addition to any other name prescribed in 33
the Revised Code or otherwise, that portion of the road known as 34
state route number thirty-nine, running in a northwesterly and 35
southeasterly direction between the municipal corporations of 36
Perrysville and Loudonville, within Ashland county only, shall 37
be known as the "Fireman First Class Irving Eugene Peters 38
Memorial Highway." 39

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 40
along the highway indicating its name. 41

Sec. 5534.16. That portion of interstate route two hundred 42
seventy running in a northerly direction from mile marker 43
thirty-three to mile marker thirty-four shall be known as the 44
"Lance Corporal Ryan E. Miller Memorial Highway." 45

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 46
along the highway indicating its name. 47

Sec. 5534.17. In addition to any other name prescribed in 48
the Revised Code or otherwise, that portion of the road known as 49
state route number sixty-two, commencing at the intersection of 50
that route and southwest boulevard and proceeding in a 51
southwesterly direction to the intersection of that route and 52
Kingston avenue in Franklin county, shall be known as the "Lance 53
Cpl. Eric J. Bernholtz Memorial Highway." 54

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 55
along the highway indicating its name. 56

Sec. 5534.19. That portion of the road known as state 57
route number ninety-three, commencing at the northeast boundary 58
of the municipal corporation of Coalton and proceeding in an 59
easterly direction to the western boundary of the municipal 60
corporation of Wellston, within Jackson county only, shall be 61
known as the "Lieutenant Stephen Byus Memorial Highway." 62

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 63
along the highway indicating its name. 64

Sec. 5534.20. That portion of the road known as interstate 65
route number seventy, running in an easterly and westerly 66
direction, commencing at the intersection of that road and 67
Wilson road and extending to the intersection of that road and 68

Hague Avenue within the municipal corporation of Columbus only, 69
shall be known as the "Sgt. Jesse Balthaser U.S.M.C. Memorial 70
Highway." 71

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 72
along the highway indicating its name. 73

Sec. 5534.21. In addition to any other name prescribed in 74
the Revised Code or otherwise, that portion of the road known as 75
United States route number twenty-three, running in a northerly 76
and southerly direction, commencing at the intersection of that 77
route and Island road and extending to the intersection of that 78
route and Little Walnut road, within Pickaway county only, shall 79
be known as the "Army Specialist Gerald R. Jenkins Memorial 80
Highway." 81

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 82
along the highway indicating its name. 83

Sec. 5534.22. In addition to any other name prescribed in 84
the Revised Code or otherwise, that portion of the road known as 85
United States route number sixty-two, running in a northeasterly 86
and southwesterly direction within Pickaway county only, shall 87
be known as the "Army PFC Kevin C. Ott Memorial Highway." 88

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 89
along the highway indicating its name. 90

Sec. 5534.23. In addition to any other name prescribed in 91
the Revised Code or otherwise, that portion of the road known as 92
state route number forty-eight, running in a northerly and 93
southerly direction between the interchange of that state route 94
and interstate route number seventy-one and the interchange of 95
that state route and state route number thirty-eight, within 96
Warren county only, shall be known as the "SFC Bobby Lee Estle 97

and Hilliard Rome road, within Franklin county only, shall be 137
known as the "Sergeant Adam L. Knox Memorial Highway." 138

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 139
along the highway indicating its name. 140

Sec. 5534.29. In addition to any other name prescribed in 141
the Revised Code or otherwise, that portion of the road known as 142
state route number seventy-three, commencing at the intersection 143
of that route and Jacksonburg road and proceeding in an easterly 144
direction to the intersection of that route and Wehr road, 145
within Butler county only, shall be known as the "SPC James E. 146
Hall, Jr., Memorial Highway." 147

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 148
along the highway indicating its name. 149

Sec. 5534.30. In addition to any other name prescribed in 150
the Revised Code or otherwise, that portion of the highway known 151
as interstate route number seventy-one, commencing at the 152
southwest boundary of Ashland county and proceeding in a 153
southwesterly direction to the interchange of that interstate 154
highway and state route number thirty-nine in Richland county 155

shall be known as the "Lt. Col. Albert L. Allen, Jr., Memorial Highway." 156
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The director of transportation may erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name. 158
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Sec. 5534.31. That portion of the road known as state route number seven, commencing at the eastern boundary of the municipal corporation of Wellsville and proceeding in an easterly direction to the western boundary of the municipal corporation of East Liverpool, within Columbiana county only, shall be known as the "Corporal William F. Bratt Memorial Highway." 160
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The director of transportation may erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name. 167
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Sec. 5534.32. That portion of the road known as state route number ninety-three, commencing at the intersection of that route and cedar street in Jackson county and proceeding in a southerly direction to the boundary of Jackson county and Lawrence county, shall be known as the "Sgt. Donald Russell Long, Medal of Honor Recipient, Memorial Highway." 169
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The director of transportation may erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name. 175
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Sec. 5534.33. That portion of the road known as United States route number sixty-two, commencing at the interchange of that route with interstate route number seventy-seven and proceeding in an easterly direction to the end of the entrance ramp onto United States route number sixty-two from Cleveland avenue northwest, within the municipal corporation of Canton only, shall be known as the "USMC LCpl Stacy (Annie) Dryden Memorial Highway." 177

Sec. 5534.34. In addition to any other name prescribed in 187
the Revised Code or otherwise, that portion of the road known as 188
state route number two commencing at the intersection of that 189
route and United States interstate route number two hundred and 190
eighty and proceeding in an easterly direction to the 191
intersection of state route number two and South Yondota road in 192
Lucas county shall be known as the "Vietnam Veterans: SP4 Arthur 193
J. Heringhausen Jr., SP4 Ervin E. Harris, CPL Gerald E. Corlett, 194
PFC Joseph G. Gill, PFC Esiquio A. Cantu, 2LT John W. Vaughan, 195
PFC Scott D. Corrello, and A1C John M. Thayer Memorial Highway." 196

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 197
along the highway indicating its name. 198

Sec. 5534.35. In addition to any other name prescribed in 199
the Revised Code or otherwise, that portion of the road known as 200
state route number six, commencing at the intersection of that 201
route and state route number four and proceeding in a westerly 202
direction to the intersection of state route number six with 203
Fremont avenue in Erie county, shall be known as the "Army 204
Specialist Dennis Ramon Memorial Highway." 205

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 206
along the highway indicating its name. 207

Sec. 5534.36. In addition to any other name prescribed in 208
the Revised Code or otherwise, that portion of the road known as 209
state route number eighty-two, commencing at the eastern border 210
of the township of Vienna in Trumbull county and proceeding in 211
an easterly direction to the intersection of state route number 212
eighty-two and United States route number sixty-two in the 213

township of Brookfield in Trumbull county, shall be known as the 214
"Lance Corporal Stanley J. Sliwinski Memorial Highway." 215

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 216
along the highway indicating its name. 217

Sec. 5534.43. That portion of the road known as United 218
States route number twenty-two, running in a northeasterly and 219
southwesterly direction from the intersection of that road with 220
Lauderman road to the intersection of that road with Clarksburg 221
pike within Fayette and Pickaway counties, shall be known as the 222
"Detective Corporal J. Phillip Brown Memorial Highway." 223

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 224
along the highway indicating its name. 225

Sec. 5534.50. In addition to any other name prescribed in 226
the Revised Code or otherwise, that portion of the road known as 227
United States route number thirty-three, commencing at the 228
intersection of East Livingston avenue and College avenue in the 229
municipal corporation of Columbus and proceeding in a southerly 230
direction to the intersection of that route and state route 231
number one hundred four, shall be known as the "John W.E. Bowen 232
III Memorial Roadway." 233

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 234
along the roadway indicating its name. 235

Sec. 5534.51. In addition to any other name prescribed in 236
the Revised Code or otherwise, that portion of the road known as 237
state route number four, commencing at the intersection of that 238
route and state route number ninety-eight within Crawford county 239
and proceeding in a northerly direction until it dead ends 240
within Erie county, shall be known as the "Rep. Frederick H. 241
Deering Memorial Highway." 242

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 243
along the highway indicating its name. 244

Sec. 5534.52. In addition to any other name prescribed in 245
the Revised Code or otherwise, that portion of United States 246
route number thirty-three, commencing at the interchange of that 247
route and John Lloyd Evans Memorial drive and proceeding in a 248
southerly direction to the interchange of that route and Happy 249
Hollow road, located within Hocking county and Athens county, 250
shall be known as the "State Senator C. Stanley Mechem Memorial 251
Highway." 252

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 253
along the highway indicating its name. 254

Sec. 5534.55. In addition to any other name prescribed in 255
the Revised Code or otherwise, that portion of the road known as 256
United States route number thirty, commencing at the boundary of 257
Hancock county and Allen county and proceeding in an easterly 258
direction to the boundary of Hancock county and Wyandot county, 259
shall be known as the "Congressman Michael G. Oxley Memorial 260
Highway." 261

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 262
along the highway indicating its name. 263

Sec. 5534.70. The following portions of state route number 264
one hundred twenty-three within Warren county only shall be 265
known as the "Neil Armstrong Memorial Way": 266

(A) Commencing at the intersection of that state route and 267
state route number one hundred twenty-two on the east side of 268
the community of Red Lion and proceeding in a southerly 269
direction to the intersection of state route number one hundred 270
twenty-three and Hart road within the municipal corporation of 271

<u>Lebanon;</u>	272
<u>(B) Within the municipal corporation of Lebanon, the</u>	273
<u>portion of state route number one hundred twenty-three known as</u>	274
<u>the state route number one hundred twenty-three bypass,</u>	275
<u>commencing at the intersection of the bypass and Hart road and</u>	276
<u>proceeding in a southerly direction to the intersection of the</u>	277
<u>bypass and state route number sixty-three.</u>	278
<u>The director of transportation may erect suitable markers</u>	279
<u>along those portions of the highway indicating their name.</u>	280
<u>Sec. 5534.71. The bridge spanning the Blanchard river,</u>	281
<u>known as the Findlay Main Street Bridge, that is located within</u>	282
<u>the municipal corporation of Findlay in Hancock county and that</u>	283
<u>is part of state route number thirty-seven, shall be known as</u>	284
<u>the "Lt. Col. Ralph D. Cole Memorial Bridge."</u>	285
<u>The director of transportation may erect suitable markers</u>	286
<u>upon the bridge or its approaches indicating its name.</u>	287
Section 2. That existing section 5533.359 of the Revised	288
Code is hereby repealed.	289
