**A BILL**

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 1  
4503.514 of the Revised Code to create the 2  
"University of Notre Dame" license plate. 3

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That section 4501.21 be amended and section 4  
4503.514 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows: 5

**Sec. 4501.21.** (A) There is hereby created in the state 6  
treasury the license plate contribution fund. The fund shall 7  
consist of all contributions paid by motor vehicle registrants 8  
and collected by the registrar of motor vehicles pursuant to 9  
sections 4503.491, 4503.492, 4503.493, 4503.494, 4503.495, 10  
4503.496, 4503.498, 4503.499, 4503.50, 4503.501, 4503.502, 11  
4503.505, 4503.51, 4503.514, 4503.522, 4503.523, 4503.524, 12  
4503.525, 4503.526, 4503.528, 4503.529, 4503.531, 4503.534, 13  
4503.545, 4503.55, 4503.551, 4503.552, 4503.553, 4503.554, 14  
4503.555, 4503.561, 4503.562, 4503.564, 4503.565, 4503.576, 15  
4503.577, 4503.591, 4503.592, 4503.67, 4503.68, 4503.69, 16  
4503.701, 4503.71, 4503.711, 4503.712, 4503.713, 4503.715, 17  
4503.72, 4503.73, 4503.732, 4503.74, 4503.75, 4503.751, 18

4503.903, 4503.904, 4503.92, 4503.94, and 4503.97 of the Revised Code. 20

(B) The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar collects in the fund as follows: 22  
23

The registrar shall pay the contributions received pursuant to section 4503.491 of the Revised Code to the breast cancer fund of Ohio, which shall use that money only to pay for programs that provide assistance and education to Ohio breast cancer patients and that improve access for such patients to quality health care and clinical trials and shall not use any of the money for abortion information, counseling, services, or other abortion-related activities. 24

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.492 of the Revised Code to the organization cancer support community central Ohio, which shall deposit the money into the Sheryl L. Kraner Fund of that organization. Cancer support community central Ohio shall expend the money it receives pursuant to this division only in the same manner and for the same purposes as that organization expends other money in that fund. 32

The registrar shall pay the contributions received pursuant to section 4503.493 of the Revised Code to the autism society of Ohio, which shall use the contributions for programs and autism awareness efforts throughout the state. 40

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.494 of the Revised Code to the national multiple sclerosis society for distribution in equal amounts to the northwestern Ohio, Ohio buckeye, and Ohio valley chapters of the national multiple sclerosis society. These 44

chapters shall use the money they receive under this section to 49  
assist in paying the expenses they incur in providing services 50  
directly to their clients. 51

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 52  
receives pursuant to section 4503.495 of the Revised Code to the 53  
national pancreatic cancer foundation, which shall use the money 54  
it receives under this section to assist those who suffer with 55  
pancreatic cancer and their families. 56

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 57  
receives pursuant to section 4503.496 of the Revised Code to the 58  
Ohio sickle cell and health association, which shall use the 59  
contributions to help support educational, clinical, and social 60  
support services for adults who have sickle cell disease. 61

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 62  
receives pursuant to section 4503.498 of the Revised Code to 63  
special olympics Ohio, inc., which shall use the contributions 64  
for its programs, charitable efforts, and other activities. 65

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 66  
receives pursuant to section 4503.499 of the Revised Code to the 67  
children's glioma cancer foundation, which shall use the 68  
contributions for its research and other programs. 69

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 70  
receives pursuant to section 4503.50 of the Revised Code to the 71  
future farmers of America foundation, which shall deposit the 72  
contributions into its general account to be used for 73  
educational and scholarship purposes of the future farmers of 74  
America foundation. 75

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 76  
receives pursuant to section 4503.501 of the Revised Code to the 77

4-H youth development program of the Ohio state university 78  
extension program, which shall use those contributions to pay 79  
the expenses it incurs in conducting its educational activities. 80

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 81  
pursuant to section 4503.502 of the Revised Code to the Ohio 82  
cattlemen's foundation, which shall use those contributions for 83  
scholarships and other educational activities. 84

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 85  
pursuant to section 4503.505 of the Revised Code to the 86  
organization Ohio region phi theta kappa, which shall use those 87  
contributions for scholarships for students who are members of 88  
that organization. 89

The registrar shall pay each contribution the registrar 90  
receives pursuant to section 4503.51 of the Revised Code to the 91  
university or college whose name or marking or design appears on 92  
collegiate license plates that are issued to a person under that 93  
section. A university or college that receives contributions 94  
from the fund shall deposit the contributions into its general 95  
scholarship fund. 96

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 97  
receives pursuant to section 4503.514 of the Revised Code to the 98  
university of Notre Dame in South Bend, Indiana, for purposes of 99  
awarding grants or scholarships to residents of Ohio who attend 100  
the university. The university shall not use more than twenty 101  
per cent of the funds it receives for purposes of administering 102  
the scholarship program. The registrar shall enter into 103  
appropriate agreements with the university of Notre Dame to 104  
effectuate the distribution of such funds as provided in this 105  
section. 106

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.522 of the Revised Code to the "friends of Perry's victory and international peace memorial, incorporated," a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws of this state, to assist that organization in paying the expenses it incurs in sponsoring or holding charitable, educational, and cultural events at the monument.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.523 of the Revised Code to the fairport lights foundation, which shall use the money to pay for the restoration, maintenance, and preservation of the lighthouses of fairport harbor.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.524 of the Revised Code to the Massillon tiger football booster club, which shall use the contributions only to promote and support the football team of Washington high school of the Massillon city school district.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.525 of the Revised Code to the United States power squadron districts seven, eleven, twenty-four, and twenty-nine in equal amounts. Each power squadron district shall use the money it receives under this section to pay for the educational boating programs each district holds or sponsors within this state.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.526 of the Revised Code to the Ohio district Kiwanis foundation of the Ohio district of Kiwanis international, which shall use the money it receives under this section to pay the costs of its educational and humanitarian activities.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.528 of the Revised Code to the Ohio association of child caring agencies, which shall use the money it receives under this section to pay the expenses it incurs in advancing its mission of sustainably improving the provision of services to children, young adults, and families in this state.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.529 of the Revised Code to the Ohio nurses foundation. The foundation shall use the money it receives under this section to provide educational scholarships to assist individuals who aspire to join the nursing profession, to assist nurses in the nursing profession who seek to advance their education, and to support persons conducting nursing research concerning the evidence-based practice of nursing and the improvement of patient outcomes.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.531 of the Revised Code to the thank you foundation, incorporated, a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws of this state, to assist that organization in paying for the charitable activities and programs it sponsors in support of United States military personnel, veterans, and their families.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.534 of the Revised Code to the disabled American veterans department of Ohio, to be used for programs that serve disabled American veterans and their families.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.55 of the Revised Code to the

pro football hall of fame, which shall deposit the contributions 167  
into a special bank account that it establishes and which shall 168  
be separate and distinct from any other account the pro football 169  
hall of fame maintains, to be used exclusively for the purpose 170  
of promoting the pro football hall of fame as a travel 171  
destination. 172

The registrar shall pay the contributions that are paid to 173  
the registrar pursuant to section 4503.545 of the Revised Code 174  
to the national rifle association foundation, which shall use 175  
the money to pay the costs of the educational activities and 176  
programs the foundation holds or sponsors in this state. 177

The registrar shall pay to the Ohio pet fund the 178  
contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 179  
4503.551 of the Revised Code and any other money from any other 180  
source, including donations, gifts, and grants, that is 181  
designated by the source to be paid to the Ohio pet fund. The 182  
Ohio pet fund shall use the moneys it receives under this 183  
section to support programs for the sterilization of dogs and 184  
cats and for educational programs concerning the proper 185  
veterinary care of those animals, and for expenses of the Ohio 186  
pet fund that are reasonably necessary for it to obtain and 187  
maintain its tax-exempt status and to perform its duties. 188

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 189  
receives pursuant to section 4503.552 of the Revised Code to the 190  
rock and roll hall of fame and museum, incorporated. 191

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 192  
receives pursuant to section 4503.553 of the Revised Code to the 193  
Ohio coalition for animals, incorporated, a nonprofit 194  
corporation. Except as provided in division (B) of this section, 195  
the coalition shall distribute the money to its members, and the 196

members shall use the money only to pay for educational, 197  
charitable, and other programs of each coalition member that 198  
provide care for unwanted, abused, and neglected horses. The 199  
Ohio coalition for animals may use a portion of the money to pay 200  
for reasonable marketing costs incurred in the design and 201  
promotion of the license plate and for administrative costs 202  
incurred in the disbursement and management of funds received 203  
under this section. 204

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 205  
receives pursuant to section 4503.554 of the Revised Code to the 206  
Ohio state council of the knights of Columbus, which shall use 207  
the contributions to pay for its charitable activities and 208  
programs. 209

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 210  
receives pursuant to section 4503.555 of the Revised Code to the 211  
western reserve historical society, which shall use the 212  
contributions to fund the Crawford auto aviation museum. 213

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 214  
receives pursuant to section 4503.561 of the Revised Code to the 215  
state of Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., which shall 216  
deposit the contributions into a special bank account that it 217  
establishes. The special bank account shall be separate and 218  
distinct from any other account the state of Ohio chapter of 219  
ducks unlimited, inc., maintains and shall be used exclusively 220  
for the purpose of protecting, enhancing, restoring, and 221  
managing wetlands and conserving wildlife habitat. The state of 222  
Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., annually shall notify the 223  
registrar in writing of the name, address, and account to which 224  
such payments are to be made. 225

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 226



receives pursuant to section 4503.562 of the Revised Code to the 227  
Mahoning river consortium, which shall use the money to pay the 228  
expenses it incurs in restoring and maintaining the Mahoning 229  
river watershed. 230

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 231  
receives pursuant to section 4503.564 of the Revised Code to 232  
Antioch college for the use of the Glen Helen ecology institute 233  
to pay expenses related to the Glen Helen nature preserve. 234

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 235  
receives pursuant to section 4503.565 of the Revised Code to the 236  
conservancy for Cuyahoga valley national park, which shall use 237  
the money in support of the park. 238

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 239  
receives pursuant to section 4503.576 of the Revised Code to the 240  
Ohio state beekeepers association, which shall use those 241  
contributions to promote beekeeping, provide educational 242  
information about beekeeping, and to support other state and 243  
local beekeeping programs. 244

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 245  
receives pursuant to section 4503.577 of the Revised Code to the 246  
national aviation hall of fame, which shall use the 247  
contributions to fulfill its mission of honoring aerospace 248  
legends to inspire future leaders. 249

The registrar shall pay to a sports commission created 250  
pursuant to section 4503.591 of the Revised Code each 251  
contribution the registrar receives under that section that an 252  
applicant pays to obtain license plates that bear the logo of a 253  
professional sports team located in the county of that sports 254  
commission and that is participating in the license plate 255

program pursuant to division (E) of that section, irrespective 256  
of the county of residence of an applicant. 257

The registrar shall pay to a community charity each 258  
contribution the registrar receives under section 4503.591 of 259  
the Revised Code that an applicant pays to obtain license plates 260  
that bear the logo of a professional sports team that is 261  
participating in the license plate program pursuant to division 262  
(G) of that section. 263

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 264  
receives pursuant to section 4503.592 of the Revised Code to 265  
monarch wings across Ohio, which shall use the contributions for 266  
the protection and preservation of the monarch butterfly and 267  
pollinator corridor in Ohio and for educational programs. 268

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 269  
receives pursuant to section 4503.67 of the Revised Code to the 270  
Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council 271  
shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner 272  
throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts. 273

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 274  
receives pursuant to section 4503.68 of the Revised Code to the 275  
great river council of the girl scouts of the United States of 276  
America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an 277  
equitable manner throughout the state to regional councils of 278  
the girl scouts. 279

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 280  
receives pursuant to section 4503.69 of the Revised Code to the 281  
Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council 282  
shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner 283  
throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts. 284

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.701 of the Revised Code to the Prince Hall grand lodge of free and accepted masons of Ohio, which shall use the contributions for scholarship purposes.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.71 of the Revised Code to the fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall deposit the fees into its general account to be used for purposes of the fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.711 of the Revised Code to the fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall deposit the contributions into an account that it creates to be used for the purpose of advancing and protecting the law enforcement profession, promoting improved law enforcement methods, and teaching respect for law and order.

The registrar shall pay the contributions received pursuant to section 4503.712 of the Revised Code to Ohio concerns of police survivors, which shall use those contributions to provide whatever assistance may be appropriate to the families of Ohio law enforcement officers who are killed in the line of duty.

The registrar shall pay the contributions received pursuant to section 4503.713 of the Revised Code to the greater Cleveland peace officers memorial society, which shall use those contributions to honor law enforcement officers who have died in the line of duty and support its charitable purposes.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.715 of the Revised Code to the

fallen linemen organization, which shall use the contributions 314  
to recognize and memorialize fallen linemen and support their 315  
families. 316

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 317  
receives pursuant to section 4503.72 of the Revised Code to the 318  
organization known on March 31, 2003, as the Ohio CASA/GAL 319  
association, a private, nonprofit corporation organized under 320  
Chapter 1702. of the Revised Code. The Ohio CASA/GAL association 321  
shall use these contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in 322  
administering a program to secure the proper representation in 323  
the courts of this state of abused, neglected, and dependent 324  
children, and for the training and supervision of persons 325  
participating in that program. 326

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 327  
receives pursuant to section 4503.73 of the Revised Code to 328  
Wright B. Flyer, incorporated, which shall deposit the 329  
contributions into its general account to be used for purposes 330  
of Wright B. Flyer, incorporated. 331

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 332  
receives pursuant to section 4503.732 of the Revised Code to the 333  
Siegel & Shuster society, a nonprofit organization dedicated to 334  
commemorating and celebrating the creation of Superman in 335  
Cleveland, Ohio. 336

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 337  
receives pursuant to section 4503.74 of the Revised Code to the 338  
Columbus zoological park association, which shall disburse the 339  
moneys to Ohio's major metropolitan zoos, as defined in section 340  
4503.74 of the Revised Code, in accordance with a written 341  
agreement entered into by the major metropolitan zoos. 342

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.75 of the Revised Code to the rotary foundation, located on March 31, 2003, in Evanston, Illinois, to be placed in a fund known as the permanent fund and used to endow educational and humanitarian programs of the rotary foundation.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.751 of the Revised Code to the Ohio association of realtors, which shall deposit the contributions into a property disaster relief fund maintained under the Ohio realtors charitable and education foundation.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.763 of the Revised Code to the Ohio history connection to be used solely to build, support, and maintain the Ohio battleflag collection within the Ohio history connection.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.85 of the Revised Code to the Ohio sea grant college program to be used for Lake Erie area research projects.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.86 of the Revised Code to the Ohio Lincoln highway historic byway, which shall use those contributions solely to promote and support the historical preservation and advertisement of the Lincoln highway in this state.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.87 of the Revised Code to the Grove City little league dream field fund, which shall use those

contributions solely to build, maintain, and improve youth 372  
baseball fields within the municipal corporation of Grove City. 373

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 374  
receives pursuant to section 4503.89 of the Revised Code to the 375  
American red cross of greater Columbus on behalf of the Ohio 376  
chapters of the American red cross, which shall use the 377  
contributions for disaster readiness, preparedness, and response 378  
programs on a statewide basis. 379

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 380  
receives pursuant to section 4503.90 of the Revised Code to the 381  
nationwide children's hospital foundation. 382

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 383  
receives pursuant to section 4503.902 of the Revised Code to St. 384  
Ignatius high school located in the municipal corporation of 385  
Cleveland. The school shall use fifty per cent of the 386  
contributions it receives to provide tuition assistance to its 387  
students. The school shall use the remaining fifty per cent to 388  
pay the expenses it incurs in providing services to the school's 389  
students that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and 390  
emotional well-being of the students. The services provided may 391  
include bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving 392  
techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and 393  
education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug 394  
abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. As a part of 395  
providing such services, the school may pay for members of the 396  
faculty of the school to receive training in providing those 397  
services. The school principal or, in the school principal's 398  
discretion, appropriate school counselors shall determine any 399  
charitable organizations that the school hires to provide those 400  
services. The school shall ensure that any such charitable 401

organization is exempt from federal income taxation under 402  
subsection 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school 403  
shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 404  
purpose. 405

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 406  
receives pursuant to section 4503.903 of the Revised Code to the 407  
Brecksville-Broadview Heights city school district. The school 408  
district shall use the contributions it receives to pay the 409  
expenses it incurs in providing services to the school 410  
district's students that assist in developing or maintaining the 411  
mental and emotional well-being of the students. The services 412  
provided may include bereavement counseling, instruction in 413  
defensive driving techniques, sensitivity training, and the 414  
counseling and education of students regarding bullying, dating 415  
violence, drug abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. 416  
The school district superintendent or, in the school district 417  
superintendent's discretion, the appropriate school principal or 418  
appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable 419  
organizations that the school district hires to provide those 420  
services. The school district also may use the contributions it 421  
receives to pay for members of the faculty of the school 422  
district to receive training in providing such services to the 423  
students of the school district. The school district shall 424  
ensure that any charitable organization that is hired by the 425  
district is exempt from federal income taxation under subsection 426  
501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school district 427  
shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 428  
purpose. 429

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 430  
receives pursuant to section 4503.904 of the Revised Code to the 431  
Chagrin Falls exempted village school district. The school 432

district shall use the contributions it receives to pay the 433  
expenses it incurs in providing services to the school 434  
district's students that assist in developing or maintaining the 435  
mental and emotional well-being of the students. The services 436  
provided may include bereavement counseling, instruction in 437  
defensive driving techniques, sensitivity training, and the 438  
counseling and education of students regarding bullying, dating 439  
violence, drug abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. 440  
The school district superintendent or, in the school district 441  
superintendent's discretion, the appropriate school principal or 442  
appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable 443  
organizations that the school district hires to provide those 444  
services. The school district also may use the contributions it 445  
receives to pay for members of the faculty of the school 446  
district to receive training in providing such services to the 447  
students of the school district. The school district shall 448  
ensure that any charitable organization that is hired by the 449  
district is exempt from federal income taxation under subsection 450  
501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school district 451  
shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 452  
purpose. 453

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 454  
pursuant to section 4503.92 of the Revised Code to support our 455  
troops, incorporated, a national nonprofit corporation, which 456  
shall use those contributions in accordance with its articles of 457  
incorporation and for the benefit of servicemembers of the armed 458  
forces of the United States and their families when they are in 459  
financial need. 460

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 461  
receives pursuant to section 4503.94 of the Revised Code to the 462  
Michelle's leading star foundation, which shall use the money 463



solely to fund the rental, lease, or purchase of the simulated 464  
driving curriculum of the Michelle's leading star foundation by 465  
boards of education of city, exempted village, local, and joint 466  
vocational school districts. 467

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 468  
receives pursuant to section 4503.97 of the Revised Code to the 469  
friends of united Hatzalah of Israel, which shall use the money 470  
to support united Hatzalah of Israel, which provides free 471  
emergency medical first response throughout Israel. 472

(C) All investment earnings of the license plate 473  
contribution fund shall be credited to the fund. Not later than 474  
the first day of May of every year, the registrar shall 475  
distribute to each entity described in division (B) of this 476  
section the investment income the fund earned the previous 477  
calendar year. The amount of such a distribution paid to an 478  
entity shall be proportionate to the amount of money the entity 479  
received from the fund during the previous calendar year. 480

Sec. 4503.514. (A) The owner or lessee of any passenger 481  
car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, 482  
motorcycle, cab-enclosed motorcycle, commercial motor vehicle, 483  
or other vehicle of a class approved by the registrar of motor 484  
vehicles, and, effective January 1, 2017, the owner or lessee of 485  
any motor-driven cycle or motor scooter may apply to the 486  
registrar for the registration of the vehicle and issuance of 487  
"University of Notre Dame" license plates. The application for 488  
"University of Notre Dame" license plates may be combined with a 489  
request for a special reserved license plate under section 490  
4503.40 or 4503.42 of the Revised Code. Upon receipt of the 491  
completed application and compliance with division (B) of this 492  
section, the registrar shall issue to the applicant the 493

appropriate vehicle registration and a set of "University of 494  
Notre Dame" license plates with a validation sticker, or a 495  
validation sticker alone when required by section 4503.191 of 496  
the Revised Code. 497

In addition to the letters and numbers ordinarily 498  
inscribed thereon, "University of Notre Dame" license plates 499  
shall bear words and markings selected by the university of 500  
Notre Dame. The registrar shall approve the final design. 501  
"University of Notre Dame" license plates shall bear county 502  
identification stickers that identify the county of registration 503  
as required under section 4503.19 of the Revised Code. 504

(B) "University of Notre Dame" license plates and 505  
validation stickers shall be issued upon payment of the regular 506  
license tax as prescribed under section 4503.04 of the Revised 507  
Code, any applicable motor vehicle tax levied under Chapter 508  
4504. of the Revised Code, a bureau of motor vehicles 509  
administrative fee of ten dollars, the contribution specified in 510  
division (C) of this section, and compliance with all other 511  
applicable laws relating to the registration of motor vehicles. 512  
If the application for "University of Notre Dame" license plates 513  
is combined with a request for a special reserved license plate 514  
under section 4503.40 or 4503.42 of the Revised Code, the 515  
license plates and validation sticker shall be issued upon 516  
payment of the contribution, fees, and taxes contained in this 517  
division and the additional fee prescribed under section 4503.40 518  
or 4503.42 of the Revised Code. 519

(C) (1) For each application for registration and 520  
registration renewal submitted under this section, the registrar 521  
shall collect a contribution of thirty dollars. The registrar 522  
shall pay this contribution into the state treasury to the 523
