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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2021, Section 49-113.2, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 49-113.2. A. Upon the death of an active or retired
19	member, the Oklahoma Firefighters Pension and Retirement System
20	shall pay to the surviving spouse of the member if the surviving
21	spouse has been married to the firefighter for thirty (30)
22	continuous months preceding the member's death provided a surviving
23	spouse of a member who died while in, or as a consequence of, the
24	performance of the member's duty for a participating municipality

1 shall not be subject to the marriage limitation for survivor benefits, or if there is no surviving spouse or no surviving spouse 2 meeting the requirements of this section, the System shall pay to 3 the designated recipient or recipients of the member, or if there is 4 5 no designated recipient or if the designated recipient predeceases the member, to the estate of the member, the sum of Four Thousand 6 Dollars (\$4,000.00) for those active or retired members who died 7 prior to July 1, 1999. For those active or retired members who die 8 9 on or after July 1, 1999, but prior to the effective date of this 10 act, the sum shall be Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00). For those active or retired members who die on or after the effective date of 11 12 this act, the sum shall be Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00). 13

B. Upon the death of a member who dies leaving no living 14 designated recipient or having designated the member's estate as 15 recipient, the System may pay any applicable death benefit which may 16 be subject to probate, in an amount of Five Thousand Dollars 17 (\$5,000.00), to the heir or heirs of the member without the 18 intervention of a probate court or probate procedures. For a death 19 benefit paid on or after the effective date of this act pursuant to 20 this subsection, the amount of such benefit shall be Seven Thousand 21 Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00). 22

C. Before any applicable probate procedure may be waived, theSystem must be in receipt of the member's proof of death and the

1 following documents from those persons claiming to be the legal
2 heirs of the deceased member:

The member's last will and testament if available; 3 1. An affidavit or affidavits of heirship which must contain: 2. 4 5 a. the names and signatures of all claiming heirs to the deceased member's estate including the claiming heirs' 6 names, relationship to the deceased member, current 7 addresses and current telephone numbers, 8 9 b. a statement or statements by the claiming heirs that no application or petition for the appointment of a 10 personal representative is pending or has been granted 11 12 in any jurisdiction, с. a statement that the value of the deceased member's 13 entire probate estate, less liens and encumbrances, 14 does not exceed the dollar limit pursuant to Section 15 393 of Title 58 of the Oklahoma Statutes, including 16 the payment of benefits from the System, and 17 d. a statement by each individual claiming heir 18 identifying the amount of personal property that the 19 heir is claiming from the System or the amount the 20 heir agrees to be paid to another person, and that the 21 heir has been notified of, is aware of and consents to 22 the identified claims of all the other claiming heirs 23 of the deceased member pending with the System; 24

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A written agreement or agreements signed by all claiming
 heirs of the deceased member which provides that the claiming heirs
 release, discharge and hold harmless the System from any and all
 liability, obligations and costs which it may incur as a result of
 making a payment to any of the deceased member's heirs;

4. A corroborating affidavit from an individual other than a
7 claiming heir, who was familiar with the affairs of the deceased
8 member; and

9 5. Proof that funeral and burial expenses of the deceased10 member have been paid or provided for.

D. The System shall retain complete discretion in determining which requests for probate waiver may be granted or denied, for any reason. Should the System have any questions as to the validity of any document presented by the claiming heirs, or as to any statement or assertion contained therein, the probate requirements provided for in Section 1 et seq. of Title 58 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall not be waived.

E. After paying any death benefits to any claiming heirs as provided pursuant to this section, the System is discharged and released from any and all liability, obligation and costs to the same extent as if the System had paid a personal representative holding valid letters testamentary issued by a court of competent jurisdiction. The System is not required to inquire into the truth

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1 of any matter specified in this section or into the payment of any 2 estate tax liability.

F. The provisions of this section shall not be subject to
qualified domestic orders as provided in subsection B of Section 49126 of this title.

G. 1. For purposes of this section, if a person makes a
qualified disclaimer with respect to the death benefit provided for
in subsection A of this section, this section shall apply with
respect to such death benefit as if the death benefit had never been
transferred to such person.

11 2. For purposes of this subsection, the term "qualified 12 disclaimer" means an irrevocable and unqualified refusal by a 13 person, including but not limited to the surviving spouse of the 14 deceased member, to accept an interest in the death benefit provided 15 for in subsection A of this section, but only if:

such refusal is in writing, 16 а. b. such writing is received by the System not later than 17 the date which is nine (9) months after the date of 18 death of the deceased member, 19 such person has not accepted the death benefit 20 с. provided for in subsection A of this section, and 21 as a result of such refusal, the death benefit d. 22 provided for in subsection A of this section passes 23 without any direction on the part of the person making 24

1 the disclaimer and passes first, to the organization providing funeral and burial services for the deceased member or, if the cost of the funeral and burial services for the deceased member has already been paid, to the person or persons other than the person making the disclaimer as further provided for in this section.

SECTION 2. 11 O.S. 2021, Section 50-115.2, is 8 AMENDATORY 9 amended to read as follows:

Section 50-115.2. Upon the death of an active or retired 10 member, the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System shall pay 11 12 to the beneficiary of the member under paragraph 13 of Section 50-13 101 of this title or if there is no such beneficiary or if such beneficiary predeceases the member, to the member's estate or, if 14 properly designated by the member, to a trust, the sum of Four 15 Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) as a death benefit for those active or 16 retired members who died prior to July 1, 1999. For those active or 17 retired members who die on or after July 1, 1999, but prior to the 18 effective date of this act, the sum shall be Five Thousand Dollars 19 (\$5,000.00). For those active or retired members who die on or 20 after the effective date of this act, the sum shall be Seven 21 Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00). 22

SECTION 3. 47 O.S. 2021, Section 2-306.3, is AMENDATORY 23 amended to read as follows: 24

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1 Section 2-306.3. Upon the death of an active or retired member, 2 the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System shall pay to the designated beneficiary of the member as defined in paragraph 17 of 3 Section 2-300 of this title or if there is no such designated 4 5 beneficiary or if such designated beneficiary predeceases the member, to the estate of the member, the sum of Four Thousand 6 Dollars (\$4,000.00) as a death benefit for those active or retired 7 members who died prior to July 1, 1999. For those active or retired 8 9 members who die on or after July 1, 1999, but prior to the effective 10 date of this act, the sum shall be Five Thousand Dollars 11 (\$5,000.00). For those active or retired members who die on or after the effective date of this act, the sum shall be Seven 12 13 Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00). SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 62 O.S. 2021, Section 3103, as 14 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 306, O.S.L. 2022 (62 O.S. Supp. 15 2023, Section 3103), is amended to read as follows: 16 Section 3103. As used in the Oklahoma Pension Legislation 17 Actuarial Analysis Act: 18

19 1. "Amendment" means any amendment, including a substitute
 20 bill, made to a retirement bill by any committee of the House <u>of</u>
 21 <u>Representatives</u> or Senate, any conference committee of the House or
 22 Senate or by the House or Senate;

23 2. "RB number" means that number preceded by the letters "RB"24 assigned to a retirement bill by the respective staffs of the

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Oklahoma State Senate and the Oklahoma House of Representatives when the respective staff office prepares a retirement bill for a member of the Legislature;

3. "Legislative Actuary" means the firm or entity that enters
into a contract with the Legislative Service Bureau pursuant to
Section 452.15 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes to provide the
actuarial services and other duties provided for in the Oklahoma
Pension Legislation Actuarial Analysis Act;

9 4. "Nonfiscal amendment" means an amendment to a retirement 10 bill having a fiscal impact, which amendment does not change any 11 factor of an actuarial investigation specified in subsection A of 12 Section 3109 of this title;

## f. which provides for a one-time increase in retirement benefits if the increase in retirement benefits is not

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a permanent increase in the gross annual retirement benefit payable to a member or beneficiary, occurs only once pursuant to a single statutory authorization and does not exceed:

- 5 (1)the lesser of two percent (2%) of the gross annual retirement benefit of the member or One 6 Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) and requires that 7 the benefit may only be provided if the funded 8 ratio of the affected retirement system would not 9 be less than sixty percent (60%) but not greater 10 than eighty percent (80%) after the benefit 11 12 increase is paid,
- 13 (2) the lesser of two percent (2%) of the gross annual retirement benefit of the member or One 14 Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00) and 15 requires that the benefit may only be provided if 16 the funded ratio of the affected retirement 17 system would be greater than eighty percent (80%) 18 but not greater than one hundred percent (100%) 19 after the benefit increase is paid, 20
- (3) the lesser of two percent (2%) of the gross
  annual retirement benefit of the member or One
  Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$1,400.00) and
  requires that the benefit may only be provided if

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the funded ratio of the affected retirement 1 2 system would be greater than one hundred percent (100%) after the benefit increase is paid, or 3 the greater of two percent (2%) of the gross 4 (4) 5 annual retirement benefit of the volunteer firefighter or One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for 6 persons who retired from the Oklahoma 7 Firefighters Pension and Retirement System as 8 9 volunteer firefighters and who did not retire from the Oklahoma Firefighters Pension and 10 Retirement System as a paid firefighter. 11 As used in this subparagraph, "funded ratio" means the 12 13 figure derived by dividing the actuarial value of assets of the applicable retirement system by the 14 actuarial accrued liability of the applicable 15 retirement system, 16 which modifies the disability pension standard for 17 q. police officers who are members of the Oklahoma Police 18 Pension and Retirement System as provided by Section 3 19 of this act Section 50-115 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma 20 Statutes, 21 which provides a cost-of-living benefit increase h. 22 pursuant to the provisions of: 23

24	has as its so	le pu	rpose the appropriation or distribution or

redistribution of monies in some manner to a retirement system for purposes of reducing the unfunded liability of such system or the earmarking of a portion of the revenue from a tax to a retirement system or increasing the percentage of the revenue earmarked from a tax to a retirement system;

6 6. "Reduction-in-cost amendment" means an amendment to a
7 retirement bill having a fiscal impact which reduces the cost of the
8 bill as such cost is determined by the actuarial investigation for
9 the bill prepared pursuant to Section 3109 of this title;

10 7. "Retirement bill" means any bill or joint resolution 11 introduced or any bill or joint resolution amended by a member of 12 the Oklahoma Legislature which creates or amends any law directly 13 affecting a retirement system. A retirement bill shall not mean a 14 bill or resolution that impacts the revenue of any state tax in 15 which a portion of the revenue generated from such tax is earmarked 16 for the benefit of a retirement system;

17 8. "Retirement bill having a fiscal impact" means any
 18 retirement bill creating or establishing a retirement system and any
 19 other retirement bill other than a nonfiscal retirement bill; and

9. "Retirement system" means the Teachers' Retirement System of
 Oklahoma, the Oklahoma Public Employees Retirement System, the
 Uniform Retirement System for Justices and Judges, the Oklahoma
 Firefighters Pension and Retirement System, the Oklahoma Police
 Pension and Retirement System, the Oklahoma Law Enforcement

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1	Retirement System, or a retirement system established after January
2	1, 2006.
3	SECTION 5. Sections 1 through 3 of this act shall become
4	effective November 1, 2024.
5	SECTION 6. Section 4 of this act shall become effective October
6	1, 2024.
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
