10 FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to teachers; requiring certain
12 teachers who take and pass certain examination to be
13 reimbursed certain amount; amending 70 O.S. 2021,
14 Section 6-106.1, which relates to mentor teacher
15 stipends; directing the allocation of funds to school
16 districts for certain purpose; directing a mentor
17 teacher to provide certain support to certain
18 teachers; providing for codification; providing an
19 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-101.9 of Title 70, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24 A teacher who is certified pursuant to Section 6-122.3 or 6-187
of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes and who, at the request of the
employing school district, takes and passes a subject area

1 competency examination required by Section 6-187 of Title 70 of the
2 Oklahoma Statutes to earn certification and teach an additional
3 subject in the school district shall be reimbursed by the school
4 district. The reimbursement shall be an amount equal to the cost of
5 the subject area competency examination.

6 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 6-106.1, is
7 amended to read as follows:

8 Section 6-106.1. ~~If funds are appropriated to the~~ A. The State
9 Board of Education shall allocate funds to school districts for
10 Mentor Teacher Stipends, ~~the~~. The funds shall be distributed by the
11 Board to the school districts to provide a stipend ~~of~~ not more than
12 Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) per year for each mentor teacher as
13 defined in Section 6-182 of this title. In addition to the
14 distribution of the five-hundred-dollar stipend, each district shall
15 also receive the district's contribution amount necessary to meet
16 the Federal Insurance Contributions Act (F.I.C.A.) requirements.

17 B. A mentor teacher shall provide guidance, support, coaching,
18 and assistance to a teacher in his or her first year of teaching at
19 an employing school district, regardless of the length of time the
20 teacher has been certified.

21 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.

22 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
23 of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby
24

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
