7 SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

8 An Act relating to Medicaid coverage; directing the
9 Oklahoma Health Care Authority to seek waivers to
10 create state plan for certain individuals; providing
11 for Medicaid coverage for women for twelve months
12 after the end of a pregnancy; increasing poverty
13 rate; providing for codification; and providing an
14 effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1011.20 of Title 56, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall seek waivers, and
20 other federal approvals, that modify the state plan to allow
21 Medicaid coverage of women for twelve (12) months after the end of a
22 pregnancy.

23 B. If either a woman for the duration of her pregnancy and for
24 the postpartum period consisting of the twelve-month period
beginning on the last day of her pregnancy, or a child under one (1)

1 year of age, is living in a family that has an income that is at or
2 below two hundred five percent (205%) of the most current federal
3 poverty level, such individual is automatically qualified for
4 Medicaid eligibility.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
