9 FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to size, weight, and load permit  
11 fees; amending 47 O.S. 2021, Section 14-122, which  
12 relates to the apportionment of fees; modifying  
13 apportionment; providing an effective date; and  
14 declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 14-122, is  
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 14-122. A. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section  
19 1104 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the first ~~Twenty Million~~  
20 ~~Dollars (\$20,000,000.00)~~ Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) of the  
21 following fees shall be deposited in the General Revenue Fund and  
22 the next Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) of the following fees  
23 shall be deposited in the Weigh Station Improvement Revolving Fund

1 as created in Section 1167 of this title to be apportioned as  
2 follows:

3 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of any fee collected for a minimum  
4 permit fee pursuant to Section 14-116 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma  
5 Statutes;

6 2. Five Dollars (\$5.00) of any fee collected for excess weight  
7 pursuant to Section 14-116 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

8 3. Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) of any fee collected  
9 pursuant to Section 14-120 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

10 4. One Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$120.00) of any fee collected  
11 pursuant to Section 14-121 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

12 B. Any fees collected pursuant to Sections 14-116, 14-120, and  
13 14-121 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes that are in excess of  
14 Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00) shall be apportioned as  
15 otherwise provided for in the sections specified in this subsection.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

17 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
18 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
