1 "SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1550.42, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 Section 1550.42. ~~A.~~ The following entities may create, publish  
4 or otherwise manufacture an identification document, identification  
5 card, or identification certificate and may possess an engraved  
6 plate or other such device for the printing of such identification;  
7 provided, the name of the issuing entity shall be clearly printed  
8 upon the face of the identification:

9 1. Businesses, companies, corporations, service organizations  
10 and federal, state and local governmental agencies for employee  
11 identification which is designed to identify the bearer as an  
12 employee;

13 2. Businesses, companies, corporations and service  
14 organizations for customer identification which is designed to  
15 identify the bearer as a customer or member;

16 3. Federal, state and local government agencies for purposes  
17 authorized or required by law or any legitimate purpose consistent  
18 with the duties of such an agency<sup>7</sup> including, but not limited to,  
19 voter identification cards, driver licenses, nondriver  
20 identification cards, passports, birth certificates and social  
21 security cards;

22 4. Any public school or state or private educational  
23 institution, as defined by Sections 1-106, 21-101 or 3102 of Title  
24

1 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, to identify the bearer as an  
2 administrator, faculty member, student or employee;

3 5. Any professional organization or labor union to identify the  
4 bearer as a member of the professional organization or labor union;  
5 and

6 6. Businesses, companies or corporations which manufacture  
7 medical-alert identification for the wearer thereof.

8 ~~B. All identification documents as provided for in paragraph 3  
9 or 4 of subsection A of this section shall be issued only to United  
10 States citizens, nationals and legal permanent resident aliens.~~

11 ~~C. The provisions of subsection B of this section shall not  
12 apply when an applicant presents, in person, valid documentary  
13 evidence of:~~

14 ~~1. A valid, unexpired immigrant or nonimmigrant visa status for  
15 admission into the United States;~~

16 ~~2. A pending or approved application for asylum in the United  
17 States;~~

18 ~~3. Admission into the United States in refugee status;~~

19 ~~4. A pending or approved application for temporary protected  
20 status in the United States;~~

21 ~~5. Approved deferred action status; or~~

22 ~~6. A pending application for adjustment of status to legal  
23 permanent residence status or conditional resident status.~~

1 ~~Upon approval, the applicant may be issued an identification~~  
2 ~~document provided for in paragraph 3 or 4 of subsection A of this~~  
3 ~~section. Such identification document shall be valid only during~~  
4 ~~the period of time of the authorized stay of the applicant in the~~  
5 ~~United States or, if there is no definite end to the period of~~  
6 ~~authorized stay, a period of one (1) year. Any identification~~  
7 ~~document issued pursuant to the provisions of this subsection shall~~  
8 ~~clearly indicate that it is temporary and shall state the date that~~  
9 ~~the identification document expires. Such identification document~~  
10 ~~may be renewed only upon presentation of valid documentary evidence~~  
11 ~~that the status by which the applicant qualified for the~~  
12 ~~identification document has been extended by the United States~~  
13 ~~Citizenship and Immigration Services or other authorized agency of~~  
14 ~~the United States Department of Homeland Security.~~

15 ~~D. The provisions of subsection B of this section shall not~~  
16 ~~apply to an identification document described in paragraph 4 of~~  
17 ~~subsection A of this section that is only valid for use on the~~  
18 ~~campus or facility of that educational institution and includes a~~  
19 ~~statement of such restricted validity clearly and conspicuously~~  
20 ~~printed upon the face of the identification document.~~

21 ~~E. Any driver license issued to a person who is not a United~~  
22 ~~States citizen, national or legal permanent resident alien for which~~  
23 ~~an application has been made for renewal, duplication or reissuance~~  
24 ~~shall be presumed to have been issued in accordance with the~~

1 ~~provisions of subsection C of this section; provided that, at the~~  
2 ~~time the application is made, the driver license has not expired, or~~  
3 ~~been cancelled, suspended or revoked. The requirements of~~  
4 ~~subsection C of this section shall apply, however, to a renewal,~~  
5 ~~duplication or reissuance if the Department of Public Safety is~~  
6 ~~notified by a local, state or federal government agency of~~  
7 ~~information in the possession of the agency indicating a reasonable~~  
8 ~~suspicion that the individual seeking such renewal, duplication or~~  
9 ~~reissuance is present in the United States in violation of law. The~~  
10 ~~provisions of this subsection shall not apply to United States~~  
11 ~~citizens, nationals or legal permanent resident aliens.~~

12 SECTION 5. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 4-109.3, as  
13 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 223, O.S.L. 2023 (26 O.S. Supp.  
14 2023, Section 4-109.3), is amended to read as follows:

15 Section 4-109.3. A. When a qualified elector applies for  
16 issuance or renewal of an Oklahoma driver license, or issuance of a  
17 state identification card issued pursuant to Section 6-105 of Title  
18 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, he or she shall be provided voter  
19 registration services as required by the National Voter Registration  
20 Act. The person shall be asked whether he or she wishes to register  
21 to vote or to change his or her address for voting purposes. A  
22 person who declines to register shall confirm such choice in writing  
23 or by electronic means. Completed electronic voter registration  
24 applications shall be electronically transmitted by the agency

1 accepting the application to the State Election Board or county  
2 election board. Completed paper voter registration applications  
3 shall be transmitted by the agency accepting the application at the  
4 close of business each week to the State Election Board in  
5 preaddressed, postage prepaid envelopes provided by the State  
6 Election Board. If a person registers or declines to register to  
7 vote, the office at which the person submits the voter registration  
8 application or the fact that the person declined to register shall  
9 remain confidential and will be used only for voter registration  
10 purposes.

11 B. No voter registration services shall be offered to any  
12 person who, at the time of an application for issuance or renewal of  
13 an Oklahoma driver license or state identification card, provides  
14 documentation that shows that the person is not a citizen of the  
15 United States. Any applicant or licensee providing an individual  
16 tax identification number to Service Oklahoma or a licensed operator  
17 pursuant to Section 6-106 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall  
18 not be provided voter registration services as the applicant or  
19 licensee is not a qualified elector pursuant to this section.

20 C. A change of address for an Oklahoma driver license or state  
21 identification card submitted by a registered voter shall also serve  
22 as a change of address for voter registration purposes if the new  
23 address is within the same county where the voter is registered to  
24 vote. If the new address is outside the county where the voter is

1 currently registered to vote, the voter shall be sent a notice and  
2 application with instructions for registering to vote at the new  
3 address. A change of address for an Oklahoma driver license or  
4 state identification card shall not be used to update a voter  
5 registration address if the registrant states in writing or by  
6 electronic means that the change of address is not for voter  
7 registration purposes.

8 D. Licensed operators shall receive fifty cents (\$0.50) per  
9 valid paper voter registration application or application for change  
10 in voter registration taken by themselves and employees of the  
11 licensed operator's office taken at the licensed operator's office,  
12 payable by the State Election Board.

13 E. Service Oklahoma shall notify the Secretary of the State  
14 Election Board of licensed operator appointments. Service Oklahoma  
15 shall notify the Secretary of the State Election Board of licensed  
16 operators qualified to issue driver licenses.

17 F. 1. At least weekly, Service Oklahoma shall electronically  
18 transmit to the Secretary of the State Election Board a complete  
19 list of identifying information that shall include the name, date of  
20 birth, residential address, mailing address, and driver license  
21 number of all applicants or licensees who have provided an  
22 individual tax identification number pursuant to Section 6-106 of  
23 Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

24

1        2. The Secretary of the State Election Board shall compare the  
2 transmitted identifying information provided pursuant to paragraph 1  
3 of this subsection with the list of registered voters in each  
4 county. The Secretary of the State Election Board shall notify the  
5 secretary of any relevant county election board of any matches based  
6 on the identifying information provided by Service Oklahoma.

7        3. Upon receipt of notification from the Secretary of the State  
8 Election Board pursuant to paragraph 2 of this subsection, the  
9 secretary of the county election board shall notify the proper  
10 authority pursuant to Section 16-123 of this title to investigate  
11 whether a violation related to voting crimes or voter registration  
12 has occurred, and any unlawful voter registration shall be  
13 automatically canceled.

14        4. The Secretary of the State Election Board shall not retain  
15 the information provided pursuant to paragraph 1 of this subsection  
16 after the completion of his or her duties pursuant to paragraph 2 of  
17 this subsection except as may be necessary when assisting with an  
18 investigation.

19        G. The Secretary of the State Election Board shall promulgate  
20 rules and procedures to implement the requirements of this section.

21        SECTION 6.        AMENDATORY        47 O.S. 2021, Section 6-101, as  
22 last amended by Section 5, Chapter 47, 1st Extraordinary Session,  
23 O.S.L. 2023 (47 O.S. Supp. 2023, Section 6-101), is amended to read  
24 as follows:

1 Section 6-101. A. No person, except those hereinafter  
2 expressly exempted in Sections 6-102 and 6-102.1 of this title,  
3 shall operate any motor vehicle upon a highway in this state unless  
4 the person has a valid Oklahoma driver license for the class of  
5 vehicle being operated under the provisions of this title. No  
6 person shall be permitted to possess more than one valid license at  
7 any time, except as provided in paragraph 4 of subsection F of this  
8 section.

9 B. 1. No person shall operate a Class A commercial motor  
10 vehicle unless the person is eighteen (18) years of age or older and  
11 holds a valid Class A commercial license, except as provided in  
12 paragraph 5 of this subsection and subsection F of this section.  
13 Any person holding a valid Class A commercial license shall be  
14 permitted to operate motor vehicles in Classes A, B, C and D, except  
15 as provided for in paragraph 4 of this subsection.

16 2. No person shall operate a Class B commercial motor vehicle  
17 unless the person is eighteen (18) years of age or older and holds a  
18 valid Class B commercial license, except as provided in paragraph 5  
19 of subsection F of this section. Any person holding a valid Class B  
20 commercial license shall be permitted to operate motor vehicles in  
21 Classes B, C and D, except as provided for in paragraph 4 of this  
22 subsection.

23 3. No person shall operate a Class C commercial motor vehicle  
24 unless the person is eighteen (18) years of age or older and holds a

1 valid Class C commercial license, except as provided in subsection F  
2 of this section. Any person holding a valid Class C commercial  
3 license shall be permitted to operate motor vehicles in Classes C  
4 and D, except as provided for in paragraph 4 of this subsection.

5 4. No person under twenty-one (21) years of age shall be  
6 licensed to operate any motor vehicle which is required to be  
7 placarded for hazardous materials pursuant to 49 C.F.R., Part 172,  
8 subpart F, except as provided in subsection F of this section;  
9 provided, a person eighteen (18) years of age or older may be  
10 licensed to operate a farm vehicle which is required to be placarded  
11 for hazardous materials pursuant to 49 C.F.R., Part 172, subpart F,  
12 except as provided in subsection F of this section.

13 5. A person at least seventeen (17) years of age who  
14 successfully completes all examinations required by law may be  
15 issued by Service Oklahoma:

- 16 a. a restricted Class A commercial license which shall  
17 grant to the licensee the privilege to operate a Class  
18 A or Class B commercial motor vehicle for harvest  
19 purposes or a Class D motor vehicle, or
- 20 b. a restricted Class B commercial license which shall  
21 grant to the licensee the privilege to operate a Class  
22 B commercial motor vehicle for harvest purposes or a  
23 Class D motor vehicle.

24

1           6. No person shall operate a Class D motor vehicle unless the  
2 person is sixteen (16) years of age or older and holds a valid Class  
3 D license, except as provided for in Section 6-102 or 6-105 of this  
4 title. Any person holding a valid Class D license shall be  
5 permitted to operate motor vehicles in Class D only.

6           C. Any person issued a driver license pursuant to this section  
7 may exercise the privilege thereby granted upon all streets and  
8 highways in this state.

9           D. No person shall operate a motorcycle or motor-driven cycle  
10 without having a valid Class A, B, C or D license with a motorcycle  
11 endorsement. Except as otherwise provided by law, any new applicant  
12 for an original driver license shall be required to successfully  
13 complete a written examination, vision examination and driving  
14 examination for a motorcycle as prescribed by the Department of  
15 Public Safety, in conjunction with Service Oklahoma, and a certified  
16 state-approved motorcycle basic rider course approved by the  
17 Department, in conjunction with Service Oklahoma, if the applicant  
18 is seventeen (17) years of age or younger to be eligible for a  
19 motorcycle endorsement thereon. The written examination and driving  
20 examination for a motorcycle shall be waived by Service Oklahoma  
21 upon verification that the person has successfully completed a  
22 certified Motorcycle Safety Foundation rider course approved by the  
23 Department, in conjunction with Service Oklahoma.

1 E. Except as otherwise provided by law, any person who lawfully  
2 possesses a valid Oklahoma driver license which is eligible for  
3 renewal shall be required to successfully complete a written  
4 examination, vision examination and driving examination for a  
5 motorcycle as prescribed by the Department, in conjunction with  
6 Service Oklahoma, and a certified state-approved motorcycle basic  
7 rider course approved by the Department, in conjunction with Service  
8 Oklahoma, if the person is seventeen (17) years of age or younger to  
9 be eligible for a motorcycle endorsement. The written examination  
10 and driving examination for a motorcycle shall be waived by Service  
11 Oklahoma upon verification that the person has successfully  
12 completed a certified Motorcycle Safety Foundation rider course  
13 approved by the Department, in conjunction with Service Oklahoma.

14 F. 1. Any person eighteen (18) years of age or older may apply  
15 for a restricted Class A, B or C commercial learner permit. Service  
16 Oklahoma, after the applicant has passed all parts of the  
17 examination for a Class D license and has successfully passed all  
18 parts of the examination for a Class A, B or C commercial license  
19 other than the driving examination, may issue to the applicant a  
20 commercial learner permit which shall entitle the person having  
21 immediate lawful possession of the commercial learner permit and a  
22 valid Oklahoma driver license or provisional driver license pursuant  
23 to Section 6-212 of this title to operate a Class A, B or C  
24 commercial motor vehicle upon the public highways solely for the

1 purpose of behind-the-wheel training in accordance with rules  
2 promulgated by the Department.

3 2. This commercial learner permit shall be issued for a period  
4 as provided in Section 6-115 of this title of one hundred eighty  
5 (180) days, which may be renewed one time for an additional one  
6 hundred eighty (180) days; provided, such commercial learner permit  
7 may be suspended, revoked, canceled, denied or disqualified at the  
8 discretion of the Department, with notice to Service Oklahoma, for  
9 violation of the restrictions, for failing to give the required or  
10 correct information on the application or for violation of any  
11 traffic laws of this state pertaining to the operation of a motor  
12 vehicle. Except as otherwise provided, the lawful possessor of a  
13 commercial learner permit who has been issued a commercial learner  
14 permit for a minimum of fourteen (14) days may have the restriction  
15 requiring an accompanying driver removed by satisfactorily  
16 completing a driver's examination; provided, the removal of a  
17 restriction shall not authorize the operation of a Class A, B or C  
18 commercial motor vehicle if such operation is otherwise prohibited  
19 by law.

20 3. No person shall apply for and Service Oklahoma shall not  
21 issue an original Class A, B or C driver license until the person  
22 has been issued a commercial learner permit and held the permit for  
23 at least fourteen (14) days. Any person who currently holds a Class  
24 B or C license and who wishes to apply for another class of

1 commercial driver license shall be required to apply for a  
2 commercial learner permit and to hold the permit for at least  
3 fourteen (14) days before applying for the Class A or B license, as  
4 applicable. Any person who currently holds a Class A, B or C  
5 license and who wishes to add an endorsement or remove a restriction  
6 for which a skills examination is required shall be required to  
7 apply for a commercial learner permit and to hold the permit for at  
8 least fourteen (14) days before applying for the endorsement.

9 4. A commercial learner permit shall be issued by Service  
10 Oklahoma as a separate and unique document which shall be valid only  
11 in conjunction with a valid Oklahoma driver license or provisional  
12 driver license pursuant to Section 6-212 of this title, both of  
13 which shall be in the possession of the person to whom they have  
14 been issued whenever that person is operating a commercial motor  
15 vehicle as provided in this subsection.

16 5. After one renewal of a commercial learner permit, as  
17 provided in paragraph 2 of this subsection, a commercial permit  
18 shall not be renewed again. Any person who has held a commercial  
19 learner permit for the initial issuance period and one renewal  
20 period shall not be eligible for and Service Oklahoma shall not  
21 issue another renewal of the permit; provided, the person may  
22 reapply for a new commercial learner permit, as provided for in this  
23 subsection.

24 G. 1. For purposes of this title:

1 a. "REAL ID Compliant Driver License" or "Identification  
2 Card" means a driver license or identification card  
3 issued by this state that has been certified by the  
4 United States Department of Homeland Security (USDHS)  
5 as compliant with the requirements of the REAL ID Act  
6 of 2005, Public Law No. 109-13. A REAL ID Compliant  
7 Driver License or Identification Card and the process  
8 through which it is issued incorporate a variety of  
9 security measures designed to protect the integrity  
10 and trustworthiness of the license or card. A REAL ID  
11 Compliant Driver License or Identification Card will  
12 be clearly marked on the face indicating that it is a  
13 compliant document, and

14 b. "REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License" or  
15 "Identification Card" means a driver license or  
16 identification card issued by this state that has not  
17 been certified by the United States Department of  
18 Homeland Security (USDHS) as being compliant with the  
19 requirements of the REAL ID Act of 2005. A REAL ID  
20 Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card  
21 will be clearly marked on the face indicating that it  
22 is not compliant with the federal REAL ID Act of 2005  
23 and is not acceptable for official federal purposes.  
24 The driver license or identification card will have a

1 unique design or color indicator that clearly  
2 distinguishes it from a compliant license or card.

3 2. Original Driver License and Identification Card Issuance:

- 4 a. Application for an original REAL ID Compliant or REAL  
5 ID Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card  
6 shall be made to Service Oklahoma.
- 7 b. Service Oklahoma employees shall perform all document  
8 recognition and other requirements needed for approval  
9 of an original REAL ID Compliant or REAL ID  
10 Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card  
11 application.
- 12 c. Upon approval of an original REAL ID Compliant or REAL  
13 ID Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card  
14 application, the applicant may take the approved  
15 application document to a licensed operator to receive  
16 a temporary driver license or identification card.
- 17 d. The licensed operator shall process the approved REAL  
18 ID Compliant or REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or  
19 Identification Card application and upon payment shall  
20 provide the applicant a temporary driver license or  
21 identification card. A temporary driver license or  
22 identification card shall afford the holder the  
23 privileges otherwise granted by the specific class of  
24 driver license or identification card for the period

1 of time listed on the temporary driver license or  
2 identification card or the period of time prior to the  
3 applicant receiving a REAL ID Compliant or REAL ID  
4 Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card,  
5 whichever time period is shorter.

6 3. REAL ID Compliant Driver License and Identification Card

7 Renewal and Replacement:

- 8 a. Application for renewal or replacement of a REAL ID  
9 Compliant Driver License or Identification Card may be  
10 made to Service Oklahoma or to a licensed operator;  
11 provided, such licensed operator is authorized to  
12 process application for REAL ID Compliant Driver  
13 Licenses and Identification Cards. A licensed  
14 operator may process the voluntary downgrade of a REAL  
15 ID Compliant Commercial Driver License to any lower  
16 class license upon request of the licensee; provided,  
17 no additional endorsements or restrictions are placed  
18 on the license.
- 19 b. Service Oklahoma employees or authorized licensed  
20 operators shall perform all document recognition and  
21 other requirements needed for approval of a renewal or  
22 replacement REAL ID Compliant Driver License or  
23 Identification Card application.

1 c. Upon approval of a renewal or replacement REAL ID  
2 Compliant Driver License or Identification Card  
3 application, the applicant may receive a temporary  
4 driver license or identification card from Service  
5 Oklahoma or an authorized licensed operator.

6 d. A temporary driver license or identification card  
7 acquired under the provisions of this paragraph shall  
8 afford the holder the privileges otherwise granted by  
9 the specific class of driver license or identification  
10 card being renewed or replaced for the period of time  
11 listed on the temporary driver license or  
12 identification card or the period of time prior to the  
13 applicant receiving a REAL ID Compliant Driver License  
14 or Identification Card, whichever time period is  
15 shorter.

16 e. For purposes of this title, an application for a REAL  
17 ID Compliant Driver License or Identification Card by  
18 an individual with a valid Oklahoma-issued driver  
19 license or identification card shall be considered a  
20 renewal of a REAL ID Compliant Driver License or  
21 Identification Card.

22 4. REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License and Identification Card

23 Renewal and Replacement:  
24

- 1 a. Application for renewal or replacement of a REAL ID  
2 Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card may  
3 be made to Service Oklahoma or to a licensed operator.  
4 A licensed operator may process the voluntary  
5 downgrade of a REAL ID Noncompliant Commercial Driver  
6 License to any lower class license upon request of the  
7 licensee; provided, no additional endorsements or  
8 restrictions are added to the license.
- 9 b. Service Oklahoma employees or licensed operators shall  
10 perform all document recognition and other  
11 requirements needed for approval of a renewal or  
12 replacement REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or  
13 Identification Card application.
- 14 c. Upon approval of a renewal or replacement REAL ID  
15 Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card  
16 application, the applicant may receive a temporary  
17 driver license or identification card from Service  
18 Oklahoma or a licensed operator.
- 19 d. A temporary driver license or identification card  
20 acquired under the provisions of this paragraph shall  
21 afford the holder the privileges otherwise granted by  
22 the specific class of driver license or identification  
23 card being renewed or replaced for the period of time  
24 listed on the temporary driver license or

1 identification card or the period of time prior to the  
2 applicant receiving a REAL ID Noncompliant Driver  
3 License or Identification Card, whichever time period  
4 is shorter.

5 H. 1. The fee charged for an approved application for an  
6 original Oklahoma REAL ID Compliant or REAL ID Noncompliant Driver  
7 License or an approved application for the addition of an  
8 endorsement to a current valid Oklahoma REAL ID Compliant or REAL ID  
9 Noncompliant Driver License shall be assessed in accordance with the  
10 following schedule:

11	Class A Commercial Learner	
12	Permit	\$25.00
13	Class A Commercial License	\$25.00
14	Class B Commercial Learner	
15	Permit	\$15.00
16	Class B Commercial License	\$15.00
17	Class C Commercial Learner	
18	Permit	\$15.00
19	Class C Commercial License	\$15.00
20	Class D License	\$ 4.00
21	Motorcycle Endorsement	\$ 4.00

22 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 1104 of this  
23 title, all monies collected from the fees charged for Class A, B and  
24

1 C commercial licenses pursuant to the provisions of this subsection  
2 shall be deposited in the General Revenue Fund of this state.

3 I. The fee charged for any failed examination shall be Four  
4 Dollars (\$4.00) for any license classification. Notwithstanding the  
5 provisions of Section 1104 of this title, all monies collected from  
6 such examination fees pursuant to the provisions of this subsection  
7 shall be deposited in the General Revenue Fund of this state.

8 J. In addition to any fee charged pursuant to the provisions of  
9 subsection H of this section, the fee charged for the issuance or  
10 renewal of a REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License shall be in  
11 accordance with the following schedule; provided, that any applicant  
12 who has a CDL Learner Permit shall be charged only the replacement  
13 fee for the issuance of the license:

20 license by a licensed operator that does process  
21 approved applications or renewals for REAL ID  
22 Compliant Driver Licenses or Identification Cards  
23 shall be retained by the licensed operator  
24 through June 30, 2023. Beginning July 1, 2023,

1                   these monies shall be retained by the licensed  
2                   operator pursuant to subsection E of Section  
3                   1141.1 of this title.

4           3. Service Oklahoma shall promulgate rules prescribing forms of  
5 primary and secondary identification acceptable for replacement of  
6 an Oklahoma driver license; provided, however, a valid and unexpired  
7 U.S. passport shall be acceptable as both primary and secondary  
8 identification.

9           B. Any person desiring to add or remove an endorsement or  
10 endorsements or a restriction or restrictions to any existing driver  
11 license, when authorized by Service Oklahoma, shall obtain a  
12 replacement license with the endorsement or endorsements or the  
13 restriction or restrictions change thereon and shall be charged the  
14 fee for a replacement license as provided in subsection A of this  
15 section.

16           SECTION 10.           AMENDATORY           47 O.S. 2021, Section 6-115, as  
17 amended by Section 55, Chapter 282, O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp. 2023,  
18 Section 6-115), is amended to read as follows:

19           Section 6-115. A. Except as otherwise provided in this  
20 section, every driver license shall be issued for a period of either  
21 four (4) years or eight (8) years; provided, if the applicant or  
22 licensee ~~is an alien~~ provides an individual tax identification  
23 number pursuant to Section 6-106 of this title, the license shall be  
24 issued for a period which does not exceed ~~the lesser of:~~

1       ~~1. Four (4) years or eight (8) years; or~~

2       ~~2. The expiration date on the valid documentation authorizing~~  
3 ~~the presence of the applicant or licensee in the United States, as~~  
4 ~~required by paragraph 9 of subsection A of Section 6-103 of this~~

6       B. Except as otherwise provided in this section, the expiration  
7 date of an initial license shall be no more than either four (4)  
8 years or eight (8) years from the last day of the month of issuance  
9 or no more than either four (4) years or eight (8) years from the  
10 last day of the birth month of the applicant immediately preceding  
11 the date of issuance, if requested by the applicant.

12       C. Except as otherwise provided in this section, the expiration  
13 date of a renewal license shall be:

14       1. For a renewal during the month of expiration, either four  
15 (4) years or eight (8) years from the last day of the month of  
16 expiration of the expiring license or either four (4) or eight (8)  
17 years from the last day of the birth month of the licensee  
18 immediately preceding the expiration date of the expiring license,  
19 if requested by the licensee; or

20       2. For a renewal prior to the month of expiration, as provided  
21 by rule of Service Oklahoma, either four (4) or eight (8) years from  
22 the last day of the month of expiration of the current license;  
23 provided, no license shall be issued with an expiration date of more  
24 than five (5) years from the date of renewal on a four (4) year

1 license or nine (9) years from the date of renewal on an eight (8)  
2 year license.

3 D. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection E of Section  
4 1550.42 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, any Oklahoma driver  
5 license that is not more than one (1) year past the date of  
6 expiration provided on the driver license shall be presumed to be a  
7 valid form of identification for the purposes of renewing an  
8 Oklahoma driver license.

9 E. Except as otherwise provided in this section, every driver  
10 license shall be renewable by the licensee upon application to  
11 either Service Oklahoma or a licensed operator, furnishing the  
12 current mailing address of the person and payment of the required  
13 fee, if the person is otherwise eligible for renewal. If the  
14 licensee is an ~~alien~~ applicant that was previously issued a driver  
15 license after confirmation by the Tax Commission to Service Oklahoma  
16 that the applicant filed a 2024 state tax return pursuant to  
17 subsection A of Section 6-103 of this title and an individual tax  
18 identification number pursuant to subsection B of Section 6-106 of  
19 this title, then the licensee shall appear before a driver license

2 ~~title~~ a licensed operator, whereupon the Tax Commission shall  
3 confirm to Service Oklahoma that the applicant has filed a state tax  
4 return for each year between the date of issuance of the license and  
5 for the year prior to the expiration of the license.

6 F. All applicants for renewals of driver licenses who have  
7 proven collision records or apparent physical defects may be  
8 required to take an examination as specified by Service Oklahoma.

9 G. When a person makes application for a driver license, or  
10 makes application to renew a driver license, and the person has been  
11 convicted of, or received a deferred judgment for, any offense  
12 required to register pursuant to the Sex Offenders Registration Act,  
13 the driver license shall be valid for a period of one (1) year from  
14 the month of issuance, but may be renewed yearly during the time the  
15 person is registered on the Sex Offender Registry. Notwithstanding  
16 any other provision of law, the cost for such license shall be the  
17 same as for other driver licenses and renewals.

18 H. Service Oklahoma shall promulgate rules prescribing forms of  
19 identification acceptable for the renewal of an Oklahoma driver  
20 license.

21 SECTION 11. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 6-122, as  
22 amended by Section 62, Chapter 282, O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp. 2023,  
23 Section 6-122), is amended to read as follows:

1 Section 6-122. Service Oklahoma may develop procedures whereby  
2 driver licenses issued under the provisions of Section 6-101 et seq.  
3 of this title may be renewed or replaced by the applicant by mail or  
4 online except for licenses to be renewed ~~or replaced by aliens~~ by  
5 applicants having previously provided proof of having filed a state  
6 tax return and an individual tax identification number as prescribed  
7 by subsection E of Section 6-115 of this title. Any license issued  
8 pursuant to this section shall be valid for a period as prescribed  
9 in Section 6-115 of this title. Service Oklahoma shall not renew or  
10 replace a license by mail or online unless the immediately preceding  
11 issuance, renewal or replacement was done in person by the  
12 applicant.

13 Provided, any person or the spouse or dependent of a person:

14 1. Who is on active duty with the Armed Forces of the United  
15 States; or

16 2. Who is currently employed as a civilian contractor with the

19 issued by ~~the State of Oklahoma~~ this state, requiring no material  
20 change, may apply for no more than three consecutive renewals or

1 SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-125 of Title 47, unless there  
3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 A. Service Oklahoma shall make space available on the  
5 credential line of the front of a driver license issued to an  
6 applicant who provided an individual tax identification number to  
7 prominently print "ITIN Non-citizen", which shall be designed by  
8 Service Oklahoma and shall serve as a notation of status as a non-  
9 citizen of the United States.

10 B. Service Oklahoma shall include the words "License holder is  
11 not a U.S. citizen and is ineligible to vote in any election" on all  
12 driver licenses affixed with "ITIN Non-citizen" as required by  
13 subsection A of this section.

14 C. An applicant or licensee who provides an individual tax  
15 identification number to Service Oklahoma or a licensed operator  
16 shall be prohibited from receiving voter registration services as  
17 described in subsection A of Section 4-109.3 of Title 26 of the  
18 Oklahoma Statutes.

19 D. For any driver license issued pursuant to Section 6-106 of  
20 Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the driver license found in Field  
21 4 shall begin with the letters "ITIN"."

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
