17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:			
18	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2021, Section 20, is			
19	amended to read as follows:			
20	Section 20. A. The Attorney General shall annually publish all			
21	of the written opinions which he or she promulgates in connection			
22	with the interpretation of the laws of the State of Oklahoma <u>this</u>			
23	state in an electronic format that is accessible to the public at no			
24	cost. One copy of the bound volume shall be sent to each state			

1 officer, the chairman of each board or commission, and the county 2 law library in each county in the state where the same shall be available to the public and an electronic copy shall be sent to the 3 Publications Clearinghouse of the Oklahoma Department of Libraries. 4 5 A copy of each annual volume is to be placed on file in the Secretary of State's Office and shall be available for public 6 inspection The Attorney General may print the written opinions in 7 bound volumes at his or her discretion. 8

9 B. The Attorney General is hereby authorized to <u>may</u> sell any 10 surplus bound volumes and requested individual copies of opinions to 11 help cover the cost of the publication, postal charges and other 12 necessary expenses. <u>and proceeds Proceeds</u> of such sales shall be 13 deposited into the fund <u>herein</u> established <u>pursuant to subsection C</u> 14 of this section.

C. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving 15 fund for the Attorney General, to be designated the Attorney 16 17 General's Revolving Fund. The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies 18 received from the sale of copies of surplus bound volumes and 19 requested individual copies of opinions and such other monies as are 20 provided for by law. Expenditures from said the fund shall be made 21 upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as 22 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and 23 Enterprise Services for approval and payment. 24
