Bill Analysis

HB 1629 provides that a felon who received a commutation that reduced the sentence to time served that has no other outstanding sentence under any other felony conviction shall be eligible to vote. Additionally, the measure provides that a felon who received a commutation for a crime that has been reclassified from a felony to a misdemeanor or received a pardon shall be eligible to vote.
