**Bill Analysis**

HB 2007 provides that a registered apprentice working under the supervision of an active mechanical contractor may sit for the examination for a limited mechanical HVAC license, limited residential journeyman license, limited residential installer license or any subspecialty to the limited mechanical HVAC license without satisfying the training or experience requirements in the Mechanical Licensing Act if the apprentice meets certain criteria outlined in the measure. The apprentice must be at least 18 years of age, have at least 6 months as a registered apprentice under the certifying mechanical contractor, and have the skills necessary to sit for the relevant examination.
