**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB 2014, requires the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to seek waivers, and other federal approvals, that modify the state plan to allow Medicaid coverage for women for twelve months beginning on the last day of the pregnancy. The measure sets the eligibility income at 133% of the most current federal poverty level.
