**Research Analysis**

HB 2263 as introduced, modifies who appoints members to the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority by establishing that the Governor, Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate are to appoint two members each. Currently, the Governor appoints all six members. The measure reduces member term length from eight years to six years, however current members are allowed to serve out the rest of their original term even if it exceeds six years. Lastly, the measure prohibits members from voting on any issue in which they have a direct financial interest and requires them to sign a disclosure document annually.

**Fiscal Analysis**
