Bill Analysis

HB 2305 creates the Oklahoma PFAS Act. The measure holds that certain protected passive receivers of perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) shall not be liable for the release of such substances into the environment. The exemption shall only apply if the protected passive receiver of PFAS manages, transports, conveys, treats, disposes of, or arranges for the transport, treatment, or disposal of PFAS, in compliance with relevant state and federal laws. The measure directs the Environmental Quality Board to promulgate rules related to the receipt, storage, treatment, and disposal of PFAS. The measure requires persons receiving aqueous film-forming foam containing intentionally added PFAS (AFFF) to submit proof to the Department of Environmental Quality of the method used to store the AFFF. The measure directs the Department to establish a fee schedule for the storage of such substances. AFFF waste generated in or transported from another state shall maintain the same classification or characterization it would receive in the state of origin. The measure bans the disposal of such waste if the state of origin bans the disposal of such waste.
