Research Analysis

HB 2316, as introduced, designates the 2-1-1 Oklahoma Coordinating Council as the official state coordinating entity for all 2-1-1 Call Centers in Oklahoma, which means it is the vehicle to develop and maintain an integrated service map and is the certifying body for information and referrals providers who wish to become 2-1-1 Call Centers. This measure declares the membership of the council and states that they must be in compliance with the Alliance for Information and Referral Systems. The Coordinating Council is also required to establish a formula for the allocation of funds to the 2-1-1 Oklahoma Revolving Fund. The Coordinating Council shall meet no less than two (2) times per year and the measure establishes a revolving fund for the council in the State Treasury.
