**Research Analysis**

The PCS2 to HB 2343 removes the felony penalty for engaging in an act of prostitution with knowledge that the person is infected with HIV. The measure makes gender neutral the provision of law which provides a misdemeanor penalty for exposing oneself or another with a contagious disease in a public place.

The measure repeals the following sections of law:

[Title 21, Section 1192](#) relating to Penalty for Spreading Infectious Diseases;

[Title 21, Section 1192.1](#) relating to Penalty for Knowingly Intending to Transfer Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV); and
